Sparrowling about tiller rope being slack now

Monday Oct the 3<sup>rd</sup>  
This day commences fine cooping oil now  
Middle fine latter wore ship shoten  
Sail so end fine saw porpois then

Tuesday Oct the 4<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences with fine weather  
Got up tackles over fore hatch employ  
Shoving down oil middle finished stow  
Latter washed ship inside and out then  
Made sail latter took in sail pumped

Wednesday Oct the 5<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences fine fixing casks  
Middle fine saw porpois latter took in  
Sail pumped ship then wore round so on

Thursday Oct the 6<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences fine with rain now  
Set mudd

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Friday Oct the 7<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences with fine weather gen  
Middle fine latter wore ship so put ship

Saturday Oct the 8<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences with fine weather at  
W. foretopal stay serving main tack middle  
Fine latter shoten sail pumped ship

Sunday Oct the 9<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences with lowry weather  
Washed off sent down fore sail for mended

Monday Oct the 10<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences fine sent down fore  
Sail middle fine latter sent up fore sail

Tuesday Oct the 11<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences fine mended mites  
Middle fine steering N by E latter N by W  
Pumped ship hauled aback muryard

Wednesday Oct the 12<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences fine made sail braced  
Forward muryard ground line middle  
Fine latter saw fin back steering N by E  
Shoten sail luffed to the wind in

Thursday Oct the 13<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences fine made sail  
Kept off N by E raised white water to  
Work rattling fore topmast rigging middle  
Luffed to the wind saw white water  
Again to forward made throw out spinn  
Whales lowered fourth mate struck got  
Stove the boat took his whale run off  
Took the boat after dusk took in the  
Top sails got ready for cutting so ends

Friday Oct the 14<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences lowry cat in the whale  
Hand mending boat middle fine latter rais  
Whales going to windward B H C so  
Hand mending boat did not see them
