

Part Active bound to

Friday Sept 12th 1856
Commenced with moderate baffling
winds at 12 P.M. Capt Wood & boat crew
started for town was gone about 1 1/2 hours
and returned weather calm and distance
to far at 4 P.M. fine trade course S. W.
by S. for Bravo middle part fresh trade
at daylight saw Fogo & Bravo at 10 E. A.M.
Capt Wood & Boat crew went on shore latter
part strong trade took in light sails and
refed the topsails so much there 24 hours

Off W side Bravo

Saturday Sept 13th
Commenced with strong trade laying off
and on at Bravo at 4 1/2 P.M. boat crew &
Capt Wood returned and balt around to the
E side of the Island middle part laying aback
at 8 A.M. Capt Wood & boat crew went
on shore to trade latter part some squally
sent on shore a cask bread & some bags of
bread. Flour rice beans &c.

Off E side of Bravo

Sunday Sept 14th
Commenced with fresh trade laying
off on at Bravo delivered a cart of flour
(14 barrels) to a shore boat at sunset Capt
Wood & boat crew returned a boat crew has
have of absence for two days. got 16 pigs
some fowls & 3 turkeys middle and latter
part light baffling wind saw a Man of
War Brigg in shore of us so much
there 24 hours

Between Fogo & Bravo

Pacific Ocean 1856

Monday Sept 15th
Commenced with light baffling wind from
all points of the compass at 6 P.M. squally
with rain took in light sails at 2 P.M.
spoke W. State Brigg of War Crampup put
letters on board of her for home at 6 P.M. had
a fine shower middle part calm at
4 A.M. a breeze from N.E. at 5 A.M. set
all sail and run for Bravo at 8 1/2 A.M.
Capt Wood & boat crew went on shore to
trade latter part calm so much there
24 hours Off Bravo

Tuesday Sept 16th
Commenced with a light air from E
S.E. laying off and on at 5 1/2 P.M. boat
returned having ship a Cook foremast
hand & storage box at 4 P.M. a
light air from N.E. course S. E. under
all sail middle and latter part
calm saw blackfish and got one to
starboard boat starboard fastened and
toggil iron drawn so much there
24 hours about 20. miles from

Bravo & Fogo

Wednesday Sept 17th
Calm lowered & chased blackfish with
out success middle part calm latter part
a light breeze from E. headed to S. E. under
all sail watch employed in boiling out
blackfish saw blackfish did not lower
so much there 24 hours in sight of
