backstays & rigging fore & aft stays &c
painted mizzenmast &c

First part pleasant latter part squally
had rain but light fair wind course S
wind to N & E

Wednesday Sept 24th
First part pleasant wind N & N. E latter
part squally wind S. & S. E headed to
S. W & S. W making & taking in sail as
the breeze requires saw one sail steering
to S. W

Lat 7. 55. N

Thursday Sept 25th
First part squally wind S. headed to S. W
latter part wind S. S. W headed to S. E
under single reefed topsails courses jibs
and spinnaker

Lat 7. 03. N Long 20. 59. W

Friday Sept 26th
All these 24 hours fine pleasant breezes
from S. S. W headed to S. E under all
sail see nothing to remark

Lat 6. 46. N

Saturday Sept 27th
All these 24 hours w. light air from
W course S. by W under all sail watch
employed in washing & painting ship
outside so end another 24 hours see
nothing

Sunday Sept 28th
All these 24 hours light breezes from S. W. &
pleasant weather headed to S. S. E under all
sail saw one sail headed to S. S. E. so
end these 24 hours see nothing to remark
