it and bent it again

All these 24 hours fine breeze from E  
course S.W. by S. main all sail saw a  
whale vessel steering S.S.E. rove new main  
braces rove the old ones for fly jib halysars  
and gaff top sail dethauler

Lat 25.37. S Long 40.25 W

Friday 24. Oct  
All these 24 hours strong breeze  
from E.N.E. course S.W. by S. at 5 P.M.  
took in light sails double reefed the  
top sails furled the jib and mainsail

Pacific Ocean 1856

Saturday 25<sup>th</sup>  
First part of these 24 hours strong breeze  
and a gale of wind from E.N.E. course  
S.W. by S. under double reefed main  
top sail & foresail had plenty of  
rain

Sunday Oct 26<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather wind W.N.W. course  
S.W. under all sail in ugly sea  
on saw finbacks

Lat 32.00 S. Long 44.52 W

Monday Oct 27<sup>th</sup>  
All day pleasant wind at daylight  
N.E. at 12 M. S. & S.S.W. headed to W  
& W.S.W. sent mainsail down & repaired  
it and bent it again

Lat 32.34. S.

Tuesday Oct 28<sup>th</sup>  
All these 24 hours strong breeze from  
S.S.W. headed to W under double ree-  
fed top sail courses jib and spanker  
at 6 P.M. moderat set all sail

Lat 32.16. S. Long 47.14. W

Wednesday Oct 29<sup>th</sup>  
Fine moderat weather saw whale  
all day was fast four different  
whales and got two one to waist  
boat one to starboard boat larboard  
boat struck and box line got foul  
and was oblige to cut
