Monday Nov<sup>r</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> 1856

All these 24 hours strong breeze from N to S. reefed topsails see nothing

Lat 43.08 S.

Tuesday Nov<sup>r</sup> 11<sup>th</sup>

Saw Whales land got on to harbor boat weather very moderate & pleasant took his head of & body in that night lay by ease & junk.

Observation

Wednesday Nov<sup>r</sup> 12<sup>th</sup>

Cut in head (cabin & junk) cleared them away & started work. head first weather very moderate & pleasant see nothing

Thursday Nov<sup>r</sup> 13<sup>th</sup>

Watchmen employed in boiling finished head & started on body weather very moderate & pleasant see nothing to remark

Friday Nov<sup>r</sup> 14<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from W headed to S. pleasant at sunset finished boiling work ship to W N W. see nothing

Lat 45.10 S. Long 58.24 W

Saturday Nov<sup>r</sup> 15<sup>th</sup> 1856

All day steady N weather very moderate & pleasant see nothing

Lat 44.00 S. Long 58.22 W

Sunday Nov<sup>r</sup> 16<sup>th</sup>

Strong wind from N W headed to N. E. & under reefed topsails foresail & jib see nothing took in sail at sunset & wore ship

Lat 43.37 S. Long 57.11 W

Bound to Pacific Ocean 1856

Monday Nov<sup>r</sup> 17<sup>th</sup> 1856

Strong breeze from W with pleasant weather headed to S. E. W under reefed topsails foresail & jib all hands employed in stowing down oil in main hatchway harbor side. Stowed down rightly five barrels Lat 44.04 S.

Tuesday Nov<sup>r</sup> 18<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours strong slight breeze from W by S. headed to S. by W making flaking in sail as breeze requires

Lat 45.11 S. Long 58.15 W

Wednesday Nov<sup>r</sup> 19<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours moderate breeze from NW to W course S. by S. under all sail see nothing

Lat 46.11 S. Long 59.25 W

Thursday Nov<sup>r</sup> 20<sup>th</sup>

All day pleasant and moderate air from E to W. headed to S. S. W see nothing

Lat 46.25 S. Long 60.09 W

Friday Nov<sup>r</sup> 21<sup>st</sup>

Blowing half a gale from S. W headed to S. E. by S. under double reefed topsails see nothing

Lat 48.25 S. Long 61.55 W

Saturday Nov<sup>r</sup> 22<sup>nd</sup>

Pleasant & fine breeze from W headed by the wind to S. S. W under all sail most of the time see nothing

At 4<sup>h</sup> P M Lat 49.36 S. Long 61.39 W
