Francisco

Wednesday May 20th
Run down the land passed Point Galera
Seagons and Capt Wood went on shore
at Esmeraldas river Chased a humpback
with two boats without success off

Esmeraldas River

Thursday May 21st
Steering to N by N under all sail
see nothing

Lat 1.45

Friday May 22nd
Saw finback, fine trade from S S E
& S W headed by the wind to E & W
under all sail day time light sail in night

Lat 2.27 N

Saturday May 23rd 1857
Saw Sporn whales chased with
four boats all the afternoon did not
get any where near them

Lat 2.44 N Supposed Long 83.44 - W
83.44 - W
86. to 87. W

Sunday May 24th
Cruised about all day looking up the
whales but could not see any thing of them
saw two whale vessels steering to the S E

Lat 2.20 N Long 83.44.

Monday May 25th
Strong breeze S. headed to N by S under all
sail fitted a new stay for M topmast stay sail to come
to the deck & set stay sail see nothing

Tuesday May 26th
Fine weather all day see nothing but por-
poises

Lat 2.41 N Long 86.40. W

Wednesday May 27th
Strong breeze S. pleasant weather see nothing
overhauled brace blocks at fore & main and
laid them

Lat 2.35 N Long 88.57. W

Thursday May 28th
Saw blackfish Sp. porpoises pleasant weather
& fine trade steering by the wind to N by S.

Lat 2.31 N Long 90.34 W

Friday May 29th
Saw Killer Sp. porpoises exchanged sign-
als with a French ship on the western
tack

Lat 2.17 N Long 91.40. W
