Got a large whale & landed boat
Nautilus in sight & began beating up
she got amongst the whale, but whether
she got a whale or not we don't know

Monday Aug 17th
Cut in & commenced boiling head & feet
Spoke ship Nautilus boiling a 70 bbl Sp.
Whale cutting

Tuesday Aug 18th
Finished head & started on body saw
Nautilus to leeward fine weather standing
on different tack, Lat 00.14 N

Wednesday Aug 19th
Finished boiling turned up 75 bbls standing
on different tack, see nothing to remark
Lat 00.25 S.

Thursday Aug 20th
Strong breezy all day overcast weather
saw finbacks, Lat 00.25 S Long 82.56 W

Friday Aug 21st
Stored down 73 bbls Sp oil see
nothing Lat 00.14 N

Saturday Aug 22nd
Spoke Ship Althine Adams of Fair Haven 32.
Mo^t out 1200 Sp. 3 am H.B. Capt Wilson came
on board see nothing to remark

Sunday Aug 23rd 1857
See nothing fine weather headed to
W by N all day Lat 00.19 N

Monday Aug 24th
See a plenty of porpoise weather very
pleasant steered E N E all day

Lat 00.16 N Long 82.22 W

Tuesday Aug 25th
Made the land and at 4 P.M. hunted
aback headed off shore fine weather
saw humpbacks in shore

Lat 00.38 N

Wednesday Aug 26th
Went in 4 miles to weather of point Galera
traded for plantains at night spoke Bark
Congam just to windward Esmeraldas had
400. humpback this season laying at anchor
all the time Off Icamaz

Thursday Aug 27th
Spoke Bark Stella of N. B. laying
at anchor 670. humpback this season
of two months spoke Ship Clifford
Waine of Fair Haven 21 mo^t out 160. Sp.
for whale Off Icamaz

Friday Aug 28th
Standing by the wind to leeward
all sail C. W. in sight off sea gun-
arter see nothing of fish track
