Tuesday Sep 1st 1852
Strong breeze from S headed to S.W. under
main & whole topsail courses jibs & spanker.
saw a finback & white water

Wednesday Sep 2nd
Strong breeze under reefed topsails
spoke Bark Helen Mar Capt Worth 19
Miles out 230. Sp. Capt 10. came on board

Thursday Sep 3rd
Strong breeze headed to W S.W. under
reefed topsails courses & jibs saw finbacks

See nothing steering by the wind to
S.W. by W & S.W.

Saturday Sept 5th 1852
Landed on Chatham Island got nothing
but a mess of fish

Sunday Sept 6th
Landed on Idiyatib or Porter
Island see nothing caught a few fish
steered for N.E. Point Albemarle

Monday Sep 7th
Commenced with Barks Aurora of Westport
Merlin & Virginia of New Bedford & Penn
of Nantucket off the Rock see

Tuesday Sep 8th
Steering N.W. by N.W. under all sail
see nothing

Wednesday Sep 9th
Steering N.W. by N.W. under all
sail wind S.E. see nothing

Thursday Sep 10th
See nothing steering N.W. by W. wind S.
repaired spanker

Friday Sep 11th
See nothing wind S. course N.W.

Lat 7.45. N

Saturday Sep 12th
Caught three blackfish & three porpoises
at night had squall thunder
& lightning had some rain
