See nothing boiled out our blackfish
turned up about ten barrels last night
had thunder & lightning and to night
the same heavy looking weather in the
N. E.

Monday Sept 14th
See nothing nearly calm all day with
rain squalls under all sail

Lat 9.41. N Long 98.54. W

Tuesday Sept 15th
Lowered twice for blackfish got two
to starboard boat two to Starboard boat
one to bow boat

Lat 9.49. N Long 100.24. W

Wednesday Sept 16th
Caught five more blackfish one to star-
board boat two to waist boat two to
bow boat & barbed them out the ten
fish made about 12 barrels weather
calm I hot see nothing

Lat 10.15 N Long 100.30. W

Thursday Sept 17th
Light air & calm saw blackfish twice
did not lower Lat 9.25. N Long 100.16. W

Friday Sept 18th
See whales and got one to starboard
boat had a thunder & lightning squall
with some rain

Lat 9.08. N Long 100.00. W

Saturday Sept 19th 1854
Cet whale in steering S by E under all
sail wind very light from N saw a
plenty of porpoises & blackfish

Lat 8.54. N Long 100.06. W

Sunday Sept 20th
Strong wind from SSW headed to S
E. & S E under all sail finished
boiling turned up 28 bbls - so much
see nothing

Observation

Monday Sept 21st
Strong breeze headed by the wind
to S by E & S E see nothing

Lat 6.18. N Long 96.30. W

Tuesday Sept 22nd
Strong breeze heading ESE & SE by
E. see nothing Lat 5.08. N Long 94.33. W

Wednesday Sept 23rd
Stored down 866 galls sperm oil and
685 galls blackfish oil see nothing
heading E. S. E. most of the time

Lat 4.13. N Long 92.53. W

Thursday Sept 24th
Fine moderate weather heading E
S. E. under all sail saw a finback

Lat 3.40. N Long 91.38. W

Friday Sept 25th
Strong trade all day saw porpoises
& one finback

Lat 2.55. N Long 89.52. W
