Prating up along shore saw Chile &  
Congaree to leeward strong breeze took  
in light sent once in the 24 hours

Monday Oct 19<sup>th</sup>  
Off Cape Blanco strong breeze took  
in light sails & put one reef in  
the fore to prevent latter part of  
them again saw blackfish twice  
Lat 4.05 S

Tuesday Oct 20<sup>th</sup> 1854  
Strong breeze all these 24 hours beating  
up the coast to Payta in sight of the  
land so much that 24 hours

Lat 4.47 S.

Wednesday Oct 21<sup>st</sup> 1854  
Strong breeze all 6. P.M anchored at  
Payta 3<sup>rd</sup> day from Tombey Payta

Thursday Oct 22<sup>nd</sup> 1854  
Fine weather one watch on liberty watch  
watch on board painting ship inside so  
much at Payta

Friday Oct 23<sup>rd</sup> 1854  
Fine weather watch on liberty watch  
on board painting & sea painting iron  
work and boats & a sold one barrel  
port to a merchant vessel 26.00 Payta

Saturday Oct 24<sup>th</sup> 1854  
Fine weather watch employed in various  
jobs about ship painted waist boat rec on  
board 12. bbls mung etc Payta

Sunday Oct 25<sup>th</sup>  
All good weather and fine breeze watch  
still on liberty Payta

Monday Oct 26<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather to day is the last day liberty  
three days for each watch getting ready  
for sea so much Payta
