

Monday Nov 9th 1854
Fine weather headed by the wind to S.
S.E. under all sail hauled N.E. course
E.S.E.
Lat 17.44 S.

Tuesday Nov 10th
All these 24 hours fine moderate pleas-
ant weather see nothing to remark
Lat 17.25 S.

Wednesday Nov 11th 1854
Fine weather strong breezes from E.S.E.
headed by the wind to N.E. see nothing
Lat 16.19 S.

Thursday Nov 12th
Strong winds steering to N.E. by the wind
see nothing to remark No observations

Friday Nov 13th
Strong breezes & moderate headed to the
N.E. took in light sails & set them again
lowered two boats for blackfish without suc-
cess
Lat 14.09 S.

Saturday Nov 14th
C/o 10 blackfish three to larboard boat three
to bow boat three to starboard boat and
one to waist boat boiled them out-
lowered again without success
Lat 13.04 S. Long 84.26 W.

Sunday Nov 15th
Our blackfish turned up 12 barrels fine
weather headed to E. by E saw blackfish
again but did not lower
Lat 12.12 S.

Monday Nov 16th 1854
Fresh breeze from E.S.E. upon ship
and steered to under all sail see
nothing Lat None

Tuesday Nov 17th
Strong E.S.E. wind course to under
all sail saw a number of finbacks
No Lat

Wednesday Nov 18th
Overcast weather wind S.E. & S.E.
course to by S. under all sail saw black-
fish did not lower Lat 11.18 S.

Thursday Nov 19th
Wind E. and strong course S. by W.
latter part altered our course to N
by W see nothing Lat 11.25 S. Long 90.27 W.

Friday Nov 20th
Strong breeze and clear weather course
N by W saw blackfish did not lower
Lat 8.28 S.

Saturday Nov 21st
Fresh breeze and fine weather sent
Gafftopsail down repaired & bent it again
saw white water but proved to be nothing
Lat 5.55 S. Long 90.04 W.

Sunday Nov 22^d
All these 24 hours fresh breeze and fine
weather carrying all sail course N by E
saw a shoal of blackfish did not lower
Lat 3.45 S Long 89.56 W.
