

Monday Nov^r 23rd 1854
Made Charles Island (Callapagos) saw
blackfish soon new fore & main topgall-
ant braces Lat 1.50 S Long 90.24 W

Tuesday Nov^r 24th
Off South Head caught a blackfish to
Harbord boat spoke Ship Peter Williams
no oil since leaving Payta a month ago
South Head

Wednesday Nov^r 25th
Strong breeze took in light sail saw
4 sail off Harbord & North Head
North Head

Thursday Nov^r 26th
Exchange signals with Sea Queen and
saw whals and got one to Harbord
boat Harbord boat struck another and
got scared and cut & let him go
Bark Aurora got a whale being all
that was got off North Head

Friday Nov^r 27th
Cut in our whale and commenced
to boil him out weather calm & pleasant
standing off & on in Co with 5 or 6 other
vessels & ends
North Head

Saturday Nov^r 28th
Finished boiling standing in and off
at
North Head

Sunday Nov^r 29th
Lammed with Sea Queen Atlantic & Peter
Williams saw blackfish did not lower
North Head

Monday Nov^r 30th 1854
Off the Rock caught a mup off fish saw
G. sail and a finback calm weather
Off Rock

Tuesday Nov^r Dec^r 1st 1854
Calm lowered for blackfish Harbord
boat struck & drew in steering for Abington
Off North Head

Wednesday Dec^r 2nd
Off Abington saw several vessels and
blackfish spoke Dominga just from
Payta
Abington

Thursday Dec^r 3rd
Saw a number of finbacks Papered Ships
Jat Lopez Atkins Adams & Bark Peru
now whaling at night spoke Peru
no oil since leaving Payta Abington

Friday Dec^r 4th
Fin weather under all sail standing in
and off at Abington also with a number
of vessels none whaling & ends
Abington

Saturday Dec^r 5th
Lammed with Helen near 88 sp since
leaving Tombez Catalpa 104 sp. since
leaving Payta - saw nothing whaling
Off Abington

Sunday Dec^r 6th
Steered off to W. N. W. & N. W. at night
saw Wellmans Island spoke Peru
again she had sprung a leak since we saw
her before and was now taking 3000 strokes
in 24 hours steered to N. W.
Wellmans Island
