wind S.W. course N.W. see nothing

Friday Dec 11th
Calm weather and equally reprieve
the fly jib course N.W. by W see nothing
Lat 7.59. N Long 95.47. W

Saturday Dec 12th
Strong trades and squally weather under
whole topsails course & jib course N.W.
see nothing to remark Lat 9.00. N Long 98.34

Sunday Dec 13th
Strong trades and pleasant weather
with a heavy swell running to W saw
one solitary school of blackfish see ones
these 24 hours

Lat 9.41. N Long 101.42. W

Monday Dec 14th 1854
Strong trades and pleasant weather
under ship and steered by the wind hea-
ding S.E. took in light sails see nothing
Lat 9.07. N

Tuesday Dec 15th
Fine trades & pleasant weather under
all sail headed by the wind to S.E.
see nothing to remark
Lat 7.44. N Long 99.23. W

Wednesday Dec 16th
Moderate weather steering by the wind
heading E.S.E. passing squalls of rain
watch employed in fitting new maintopgall-
abrigging see nothing to remark
Lat 7.00. N Long 97.56. W

Thursday Dec 17th
Equally looking weather light air from
N.E. under all sail headed to E by S.
latter part wind S.W. & equally course E by
S. see nothing Lat None & No Long

Friday Dec 18th
Equally baffling weather under all sail
course S.E. see nothing to remark
Lat 5.27. N Long 95.29. W

Saturday Dec 19th
All these 24 hours light baffling air from
S. & W. course S.E. under all sail see
nothing to remark Lat No

Sunday Dec 20th
Strong breeze from S squally some headed
by the wind to E.S.E. see nothing
Lat 3.32. N Long 91.50. W
