

Monday Dec^r 21st 1857
Strong breeze from S. under all sail
steering by the wind to E S E. see nothing
Lat 2.20. N Long 91.30. W

Tuesday Dec^r 22nd
Light air and squally thick weather
under all sail standing on the tack
to make the most southing saw whale
all day. Larboard & bow boats chased a
school off and did not get near them and
did not get to the ship until 2 P.M. Starboard
boat got a whale waist boat chase around
all day and did not get fast cut him
in and stood to E S E. see ones
Lat 2.10. N Long 91.00. W

Wednesday Dec^r 23rd
Boiling under all sail thick drizzly weather
see nothing to remark whale made about
28.666 Lat 2.02. N Long 91.35. W

Thursday Dec^r 24th
Overcast rainy weather. and then pleasant
saw porpoise we are beating up to Gallapagos
Islands Lat 1.38. N Long 91.02. W

Friday Dec^r 25th
Overcast weather under all sail bea-
ting up. to Rock see nothing to remark
Lat 1.27. N

Saturday Dec^r 26th
Calm thick weather at 10 A.M. cleared up
some strong breeze from S. saw Albatross
a long way off - see ones

Sunday Dec^r 27th
Fine breeze still beating to windward saw the
land to windward saw three vessels to wind-
ward
North Head in sight
Lat 00.38. N Long 91.53. W

Monday Dec^r 28th 1858
Capt Wood went on board Bark B. Cum-
mings Ship Nautilus & Phillip Delnoye Bark
Ship Betsy Williams also in Co off
See Bay

Tuesday Dec^r 29th
Fine Moderate breeze standing off to on
saw Dominga to windward had taken
a whale the week before which made 122.
666 Capt Wood went on board B. C.
See Bay

Wednesday Dec^r 30th
Moderate pleasant weather six sail in
sight lowered for blackfish without suc-
cess see ones See Bay

Thursday Dec^r 31st
Spoke ship Mary Wilder just from Punta
at 6 P.M. Phillip Delnoye Betsy Williams
& Bark Dominga all in Co
See Bay

Friday Jan^y 1st 1858
Examined with Phillip Delanoys and
let him have a cask of coal & took whale
bones in exchange see nothing of the
whale specie to sail in sight

Saturday Jan^y 2^d 1858
Bound for Abington one sail in sight
weather calm and strong current
see ones see nothing North Head

Sunday Jan^y 3^d
Steering off to the N & E saw Mary Wilder
headed to Eastward see nothing to
remark
Lat
