Wednesday Jan 7<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather steering by the wind to E  
S. E made foretopmast staysail larger by  
putting three more cloths in it unbent  
main spencer sent down gaff and rig-  
ging spoke Bark Islander of Nantucket 16  
Mo<sup>o</sup> out 250 Sp. bones to Lomby from Japan  
saw whales at night so late & whales to wind-  
ward did not lower

No Observation

Thursday Jan 7<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather at 11<sup>h</sup> A M saw a sp. whale  
to leeward lowered all the boat he was  
going quiet and could not get any  
where near him kept on chasing larboard  
& bow boat at 6 P M got a small whale  
to the larboard boat the only chance so  
much

Friday Jan 8<sup>th</sup>  
Cut in our whale and made sail headed  
to S. W at 4<sup>h</sup> P M saw whales again at  
5<sup>h</sup> lowered all boats and at 8<sup>h</sup> had three  
whales to the ship got to waist boat bow  
boat & Starboard boat so ind three whales  
along side

Saturday Jan 9<sup>th</sup> 1858  
At day light saw whale lowered three  
larboard boats chase to leeward waist boat  
got a whale bow boat struck & iron bit  
struck again & drew larboard boat me  
saw a whale came on board and cut  
in ~~two~~ <sup>all the</sup> whales so ind commenced boiling  
& clearing away heads & c

Fine moderate weather boiling see nothing  
to remark  
Long 00.05. S Long 85.35. W

Monday Jan 11<sup>th</sup>  
Fresh breeze from S. standing on differ-  
ent tacks watches employe in boiling  
see ind these 24 hours see nothing  
Lat 00.16. S.

Tuesday Jan 12<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather finished boiling turned up  
over one hundred barrels. very fine wea-  
ther standing on different tacks see noth-  
ing to remark  
Lat 00.30. S.

Wednesday Jan 13<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather saw fin back see nothing  
Lat 00.30. S.

Thursday Jan 14<sup>th</sup>  
Spoke Hector stowed down see nothing  
Lat 1.01. S.

Friday Jan 15<sup>th</sup>  
Finished stowing down (Wharrels) see nothing  
Lat 00.48. S Long 85.41. W

See nothing
