Remarks on Board the Brig Colburn of 1845

Friday 14th the Begins with light airs and calm put the 8th boat on the crails saw five bark employed at ships duty the middle and latter part calm people employed at all sorts of work so ends
 Lat by obs 30-50 North Long by chro 35-54 West

Saturday 15th the Begins with calm people employed at ships duty saw 5 olive cores the middle part calm the latter a light breeze from E.S.E. turned up salaried boat and painted his people employed at ships duty making spurs again Lat by obs 30-55 North Long by chro 35-59 West

Sunday 16th the Begins with a light breeze from E.S.E. heading South saw two sail steering N.E. the middle saw two sail steering the same and both spoke us his long was 36-00 frame not known the latter part strong breezes from S.E. East saw several sail Lat by obs 29-00 North Long by chro 36-10 West

Monday 17th the Begins with a strong breeze from the same carrying all sail saw several sail steering N.E. the middle and latter part the same people employed at ships duty a breeze from S.E. so ends
 Lat by obs 27-10 North Long by chro 35-41 West

Tuesday 18th the Begins with a strong breeze from E.S.E. heading South saw five barks the middle and latter part squally saw one sail steering to the West people employed at ships duty so ends
 Lat by obs 25-40 North Long by chro 35-25 West

Wednesday 19th the Begins with a fine breeze but squally saw one sail steering west wind from E.S.E. heading South the middle and latter a fine breeze employed at braking out hold for fish found none wind from E.S.E. to S.E. so ends this 24 hours
 Lat by obs 24-15 North Long by chro 34-51 West

Thursday 20th the Begins with a fine breeze from East employed in braking out main and 4th 2nd At 4 PM calm and rainy At 4 PM it breezes latter part a strong breeze from E.S.E. people employed at ships duty
 Lat by obs 22-55 North Long by chro 34-24 West

E. Cushman, H. Cushing Master, A. D. 1845

Friday 21st the Begins with a fine breeze from E.S.E. saw two sail steering west people employed at ships duty the middle and latter part a fine breeze people employed at sundry jobs took a distance found him in the long 34-48 West so ends this 24 hours
 Lat by obs 21-00 North Long by chro 33-55 West

Saturday 22nd the Begins with a light breeze from East people employed at ships duty saw two sail steering to the westward the middle and latter part the same people employed at ships duty got a distance agreed with the chronometer so ends this 24 hours
 Lat by obs 19-38 North Long by chro 33-20 West

Sunday 23rd the Begins with a fine breeze from East people employed at ships duty the middle and latter part a strong breeze from E.S.E. so ends this 24 hours
 Lat 18-05 North Long 32-50 West

Monday 24th the Begins with a strong breeze from E.S.E. sharp on the wind saw two sail steering N.E. gave the men their share of molasses the middle and latter part a strong breeze from East took in fore top galiant sail people employed plating sinnet so ends this 24 hours
 Lat by obs 15-50 North Long by chro 31-06 West

Tuesday 25th the Begins with a strong breeze from East employed in getting out water forward of the main hatch the middle and latter part the same saw porpoises so ends this 24 hours with a fine breeze
 Lat by obs 13-46 North Long by chro 30-08 West

Wednesday 26th the Begins with a fine breeze from East people employed at ships duty boat steering employed in grinding harpoons the middle and latter the same sent down fore top galiant sail and repaired it Lat by obs 12-06 North Long by chro 28-12 West

Thursday 27th the Begins with a fine breeze from East saw a brook on water horn At 2 PM took ship At 4 PM took a gain to the south set up fore topmast back stays the middle and latter part the same people employed at ships duty so ends this day Lat by obs 10-50 North Long by chro 28-12 West

Friday 28th the Begins with a fine breeze from E.S.E. People employed at ships duty the middle and latter the same the middle part headed the course S.E. Lat by obs 9-42 North Long by chro 28-02 West
