Saturday 27th the Begins with a fine breeze from N.E. by E. finished taring down main rigging broke out left hold the middle and latter part same stored S.E. by S people employed at ships duty so ends Sat by obs 7:08 North Long by chro 24:50 West

Sunday 28th the Begins with a fine breeze from E.N.E. stored S.E. by S saw two sail steering N.W. the middle and latter the same so ends this Sat by obs 6:26 North Long by chro 24:50 West

Monday 29th the Begins with a light breeze from S.E. the middle and latter part light airs and squally people employed at ships duty saw porpoise caught a screech owl so ends this 24 hours wind from S.E. Sat by obs 5:16 N Long by chro 23:17 West

Tuesday 30th the Begins with a light breeze and squally saw a sail wind from S.E. heading S.W. the middle and latter part the same saw one sail three the night saw grampouses porpoises so ends Sat by obs 5:53 North Long by chro 23:48 West

Wednesday 31st the Begins with a fine breeze from S.E. broke out main hold for water the middle and latter part the same heading from S.E. to N.W. so ends this 24 hours Sat by obs 2:26 North Long by chro 25:04 West

Thursday 1st the Begins with a fine breeze from South the middle part the same the latter a breeze from S.E. saw a great quantity of birds so ends this 24 hours with strong Sat by obs 2:13 North Long by chro 26:41 West

Friday 2nd the Begins with a light breeze from S.E. at 10 AM saw black fish lured did not get any the middle and latter the same saw a fin back Sat 10:10 South Long 2:10 W

Saturday 3rd the Begins with a light breeze from S.E. took a distance the middle and latter part the same people employed in putting battens on the rail set up main top galiant back stage so ends this 24 hours Sat by obs 4:55 South Long by chro 28:10 West

Jonathan H. Cushing Master Remarks in 1845

Sunday 7th the Begins with a fine breeze from S.E. to S.W. at 4 PM took a distance 30 miles west of chronometer the middle and latter the same stored S.W. by S saw grampouses so ends this day Sat by obs 5:52 South Long by chro 29:21 West

Monday 8th the Begins with a light breeze from S.W. at 4 PM took a distance east of the chro 40 miles the middle part moderate the latter a fine breeze broke out main hold for bread and water broke out after hold for beef and meal so ends this 24 hours Sat by obs 5:23 South Long by chro 30:30 West

Tuesday 9th the Begins with a fine breeze from S to E.S.E. people employed at ships duty the middle and latter the same people employed at ships duty saw a m bark steering to the N.W. so ends Sat by obs 7:43 South Long by chro 31:58 West

Wednesday 10th the Begins with a light breeze from E steering S.E. people employed at ships duty the middle part caught a porpoise the latter all hands setting a top rigging fore and aft steering S.W. west so ends Sat by obs 9:21 South Long by chro 32:20 West

Thursday 11th the Begins with a light breeze from N.E. steering the same people employed setting up rigging and other sundry jobs the middle part light breezes the latter part more breeze saw a fin back so ends this 24 hours with a fine breeze Sat by obs 11:14 N Long by chro 32:57 West

Friday 12th the Begins with a fine breeze N.W. & stored S.W. by S people employed at ships duty and all sail set as required the middle and latter part the same breeze from N.W. by E stored S.W. by S Sat by obs 10:56 South Long by chro 33:57 West

Saturday 13th the Begins with a fine breeze from N.W. steering S.W. by S people employed at ships duty the middle and latter part the same people employed picking up copper made a case bucket I made three lumps so ends Sat by obs 16:04 South Long by chro 35:27 West
