Remarks on Board the Cutterwood in April

April Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with strong breezes from South steered to the North at 4 Pm luffed by the wind to the south at 12 noon ship to the S.E. At 8 Am steered N saw theinga cutting sea a large bark gaming with him set fore topsail Wind from South Lat by obs 38-07 Long by chro 45-49 West

Monday 6<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with a strong breeze from the same steered N saw a bark the middle part a fine breeze At daylight saw a sperm whale going to the leeward Wind from S.S.W. At sunrise bore struck and killed took him at long 15 At 15 of twelve struck to the late boat Lat 37-20 S Long 46-15 W

Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with a fine breeze from South commenced cutting at 4 Pm the mid part fine the latter the same At 10 Pm got the head off and commenced on the back saw a English half spoke bark named N.W. Ballard so on Lat by obs 37-17 South Long by chro 46-30 West

Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with a fine light breeze from the S.W. finished cutting at 10 in the night sailing the cap in the morning started the pieces the latter part fine so ends this 24 hours saw a bark Lat by obs 38-20 South Long by chro 46-00 West

Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with a fine breeze sailing to St watch first watch on deck the middle part steering the latter a gale of wind boaled down so ends Lat 38-07 Long by chro 46-00 West

Friday 10<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with strong breezes and ruggid boiling wind from S.W. on both decks the middle and latter part the same so ends this 24 hours Lat by obs 37-44 South Long by chro 45-13 West

Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with a strong breeze from S.W. sailing saw a bark the middle and latter the same a heavy swell on rooking keel out so ends this day saw bark burnt my boots with ashes Lat by obs 37-00 South Long by chro 45-20 West  
Stowed down 26 bls in the hold

Remarks of Cushing Master

Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with a fine breeze from West commenced steering down the head finished boiling at 4 Pm the latter part steering down and washed off decks so ends Lat by obs 37-27 South Long by chro 45-25 West

Monday 13<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with a light breeze N.W. heading to the North had a watch below the middle part fine the latter the same finished steering down 98 bls so ends Lat by obs 38-55 S Long by chro 45-23 West

Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with fine pleasant weather wind from West steered to the North washed off decks the middle and latter part the same people employed at ships duty so ends this day Lat by obs 36-06 S Long by chro 45-15 West

Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with a light breeze from N.W. saw a bark steering the same to the West by South the middle and latter part the same people employed at ships duty so ends Lat by obs 35-37 Long by chro 46-42 West

Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with a fine breeze from N.W. steered to the west sent up fore topsail galiant yard the middle part winds from N to S.W. the latter wind from S.W. steering N with squalls of rain Lat 38-00 S Long 47-57 West

Friday 17<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with light breezes from S.W. steered North sent up fore top galiant sail sent in fore top mast staysail the middle part the same the latter steering breezes from West repaired stay sail feathered jib pennants with all sails set from Lat by obs 38-08 S Long by chro 47-59 West

Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with a strong breeze steered with fore top galiant sail the middle and latter light breezes repaired foresail to a distance jib and flying jib left in the east so ends this 24 hours Lat by obs 38-24 South Long by chro 47-10 West

Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> the Breeze with light airs and calm steered North repairing foresail at sundown took in top galiant sails lered the topsails down on the cap the middle part light breeze from North on both decks the latter the same so ends this Lat by obs 38-07 South Long by chro 47-05 West
