Sunday 3 the Brigins with fine pleasant weather got a raft on board in the after noon the middle part the same at 4 AM St watch went on liberty at dark came on board so ends this day

Monday 4 the Brigins with fine weather St watch on liberty took a raft of water on board brought on cock people on shore taking comfort all the water is on board so ends this day very hot and sultry

Tuesday 5 the Brigins with the same the St watch got drunk I have been sick three out the day St watch employed in painting the brig St side Capt took some Calico so ends this day

Wednesday 6 the Brigins with fine weather Richard Golden and Edwin Dowell left the brig some way this day did nothing but set up flying jibs gies and sent down main top galant yard felled near foot ropes aboard watch on shore received one small pig and so Pinkins at dark Jacob scriber came on board

Thursday 7 the Brigins with fine weather St watch on liberty two more men seen a way John Michels and George Hows Richard Golden Edwin Dowell got 5 pigs to day painted the other side so ends

Friday 8 the Brigins with fine weather aboard watch on shore no more liberty 5 of the men went coast the bay to the lare town got a lot of oranges so ends this 24 hours did nothing on board but fit fore top mast stay felled in y bop

Saturday 9 the Brigins with thick and light rainy the middle part rainy and a strong breeze from S. to West got a boat load of wood and 3 pigs cleared up decks and so all hands to work the current sets the way the wind blows killed a pig

Sunday 10 the Brigins with at daylight got a boat load of water St watch liberty on shore rain all day did nothing three out the day so ends this is leave

Monday 11 the Brigins with a rainy day got two 500 of wood and a lot of oranges killed a pig aboard watch on liberty shipped three men all portugese Peter and Carinthian Joseph He may all ready for sea

Tuesday 12 the Brigins with thick and rainy in the morning got 300 4 thousand oranges took the anchor at 10 AM after getting out found a man a board by the name of Lewis so ends this day at 12 o'clock light breeze and calm

Wednesday 13 the Brigins with light air and calm in or 15 miles from the town the middle and latter part light breezes and calm with showers of rain from all points of the compass steered S by E saw two small sail stand in bay

Thursday 14 the Brigins with calm and rain killed two pigs course S by E stood down the small leave the middle and latter the same with showers of rain land in sight Lat 24-11 S

Friday 15 the Brigins with the same light breeze course S by E the middle and latter part the same employed at ship duty so ends this day saw plenty bump backs land out of sight course S by E light air and fine breeze from S to South
