Sunday 17th the Begins with calm winds from all quarters At 4 Pm Hilled a pig the middle and latter part a steady breeze from E.S.E. steered to the South so ends Lat by obs 26.48 South Long by chro 48.00 West

Monday 18th the Begins with a light breeze from East steered to the S.E. nothing in sight the middle and latter part a fine breeze from N.E. & by S saw a hump back so ends this day Lat by obs 28.12 South Long by chro 48.30 West

Tuesday 19th the Begins with a fine breeze from S. steered to the S.E. the middle and latter steered East At 7 in the morning saw spots in the weather been called them sperm whales but did not know for certain took to the windward low them but did not get near enough to lose Lat 28.44 S Long 48.00 West

Wednesday 20th the Begins with a fine breeze from S.W. steered east At 3 1/2 took in top gallant sails set up main top gal back stay At 10 top g rigged the middle and latter part the same saw a spot Lat by obs 29.09 South Long by chro 40.00 West

Thursday 21th the Begins with a fine breeze with all sail set steered East spoke an English brig At 5 1/2 bound to Walpurga the middle and latter more breeze At 10 took in latter top gallant sails At 6 1/2 in the morning set the main Lat by obs 29.16 South Long 37.42 West

Friday 22th the Begins with a strong breeze from the same steered East made humps the middle and latter part the same so ends this day Lat by obs 29.23 South Long by chro 34.45 West

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Saturday 23th the Begins with a strong breeze from North steered E by N all sail set At 8 took in top gal sails threw the night doubled reefed topsails At 10 took in jib topsail and mainsail Lat 29.10 South Long 34.45 West

Sunday 24th the Begins more moderate steered E.N.E. set jib and mainsail At 4 Pm steered E by N wind from N.W. Hilled a pig noon 53 the middle and latter thick rain wind from N. to S.W. At 11 1/2 shifted to the South Long — 29.30 West

Monday 25th the Begins with a strong breeze and rain doubled reefed topsails a squall from South still raining Coarse S.W. At 4 Pm wind from S.E. the middle and latter part the same At daylight killed 1 hawl saw a sail so ends Lat by obs 28.10 South Long by chro 28.15 West

Tuesday 26th the Begins with fine weather no rain heading to the N.E. wind from E.S.E. Hilled a pig weighed 49 1/2 lb the middle and latter part squally saw five backs so ends this Lat by obs 28.50 S Long by chro 26.50 West

Wednesday 27th the Begins with the same wind from N.E. steered E by S the middle and latter part brisk breezes from N.W. steered E by S so ends this day Lat by obs 27.50 S Long by chro 24.00 West

Thursday 28th the Begins with moderate and cloudy with rain and squalls middle moderate and clear set all sail and the topmast studdensail steered E by S Lat by obs 27.50 S Long by chro 21.52 West

Friday 29th the Begins with fine weather wind from N.W. steered E by S saw plenty finbacks the middle and latter part fine all sail set repaired main top gallant sail steered E by S Lat by obs 27.57 S Long by chro 17.25 West
