Monday 15th Begins with the same. At 2 P.M. saw
L. whaleman spake him at 5 P.M. the bark Ca
thelot the middle. And latter part the same
said bark in sight all day he kind to 2nd
Lat by obs 14.45 South Long 103-10 West

Tuesday 16th. Begins with light breezes from
 S. E. to the South at 12 in. the night
 wore ships. At 2 A.M. heard whales spout
 3 or 4 of them tho. rather light air stood
 N. E. for them saw five backs saw said backs.
 Left by obs 14:19 So Long by obs 08:42 West.

At Modoc Ferry 14th ¹⁶ Agassiz with the same shipped
to the North the Middle. Kind latter part the
same saw the Cattle lot so ends this 24 hours
Left by A. 17 = 28 S Long by C. 18 = 12.50 West

Thursday 18th ^{the} begins with a fair breeze from S.E.
At sundown spoke the Catallet saw a junk of
S. ship at 10 more ship the middle and latter
the same with light air and calm so 2 mds
left by 14:30 S. Long by Chro 8:48. off 27

Friday 19th ⁵⁴ Begins with light air from East
At 3 pm lured for a hump back did not
get with in a mile of him. The middle bird
better part the same took a Distance 14 1/2 m.
So ends with 14.56 S Long by C. h. 2200 West

Saturday 20th the off begins the same At 3 pm started to the S. & S. from N. & S. the middle and latter part the same saw humblarks At 4 pm light saw a sail. so I was out from N. & S. at 4.40 by obs 44.40 & long by Chrs 0.40 West

Monday 23rd The Begins with a strong breeze.
Saw 4 m ships employed in plating gaskets.
At 12 were 2 ships the middle and latter, a
strong breeze, saw a whaler on the water
Left by abt 14:15 & Lay by Chro. 02:35 off.

Wednesday 24th the begins with the same. At
Sunday morning ship at daylight saw bark catches
stood to the south saw 3 in bark and him in
bark every day since first struck on the ground
Last by 44-47 South Long 22-20 West 10
Sailed in the Bark Pothalene July 2nd 1855
on a whale whaler to 1855

Thursday 25th Begins with a fine breeze from S.E.
stood to the S.W. the middle part wore ship to
the S.W. with a fine breeze so I made this day
Jas. and the mate had a gaye before we put
Sail by abt 12.58 & Long by Chro 02.15 West
South Atlantic

Friday 26th the Begonia with the same At 4 P.M. saw
the middle and latter part signalling. It signalled
mass. ship under double raked sprails so &
left by abt 17:53 South Long 16 30 or 39 West

Saturday 24th Begins with strong breeze and squalls. At 4 Pm saw a vessel the middle of the horizon. part the same so small this day repaired jib & stowed to the S. W. Left by abt 11.45 South Long by Chro. 02.50 off.
