Saturday 28th the begins with light air and calm at 2:50 PM took a lunar observation the middle and latter part calm saw breeze had a duck for dinner set up main rigging turned in top mast back stays so ends

Monday 31st the begins with the same spoke at 2 PM saw 4 yellow tails the middle and latter part calm and rainy saw 4 sail whaler and one slaver lots of humpbacks so ends

Tuesday 1st the begins with light air all round the July 1st compass the middle and latter part the same winds from all quarters of the compass so ends

Wednesday 2nd the begins with the same bark out for July 2nd the middle and latter part a fine breeze from S.E. steered to the S.W. so ends

Thursday 3rd the begins with a strong breeze saw fin July 3rd the middle and latter part strong breeze saw a bark steering for St. Helena so ends

Friday 4th the begins with a strong breeze from S.E. at 1 PM saw two ships steering the same last night tacked ship to the N.E. the middle and latter part the same at 8 PM steered S.W.

Saturday 5th the begins with a fine breeze steered before the wind to cruise west of the island at 1 PM down hipped to the S.W. under double reef tops at daylight steered N.W. by N saw two sail steering the same left on main stay so ends
