Sunday 26th the Bogins with a fine breeze and July equally showers of rain the middle and latter part the same so ends this 24 hours with whole topsails Latt 17-10 S Long by Chro 14-48 West

Monday 27th the Bogins with the same steered west the middle and latter part lighter breezes from S steered W by S saw hump backs so ends this day Latt by obs 17-55 S Long by Chro 15-48 West

Tuesday 28th the Bogins with a light breeze from East the middle and latter part the same set up main stays and had been hump backs so ends this day Latt by obs 14-22 S Long by Chro 17-50 West

Wednesday 29th the Bogins with a light breeze from S by W steered W by S took a lunar observation at 3 PM 10 miles west of Chro the middle part the same at 4 AM took a light breeze from West light air and calm Latt 48-54 S Long 18-20 West

Thursday 30th the Bogins with the same tacked to the North west at sundown took in J and main topsails the middle and latter part the same Latt by obs 14-42 S Long by Chro 18-55 West

Friday 31st the Bogins with light air from S by W August heading to the N by W set on main stay the middle and latter part light breezes from S steered N by W Latt 18-40 S Long by Chro 20-00 West

Saturday 1st the Bogins with the same saw hump backs steered N by W a fine breeze from S by W August 8 steered N by S steered whole weather three to night Latt by obs 19-23 S Long by Chro 22-15 West

Sunday August 2nd the Bogins with a fine breeze from the same the middle and latter part the same saw fin backs so ends this 24 hours Latt by obs 20-16 S Long by Chro 24-55 West

Monday 3rd the Bogins with a strong breeze from S by E steered August west the middle and latter part the same saw plenty fin backs and hump backs so ends Latt by obs 20-39 S Long by Chro 27-15 West

Tuesday 4th the Bogins with a fine breeze from the same steered N by W at 5 PM landed a hump back at dark took in topsails and set hauled up the foresail at 2 in the morning saw martin nest rocks and luffed by the wind to the S E wind from N by E at daylight steered in so ends Latt by obs 20-38 S Long West rocks (miles) martin nest - largest

Wednesday 5th the Bogins with the same sail and waist boat went fishing and lost the blacker hook caught two strap tubs full at sundown came on board steered from Trinidad tacked at 1 AM off steered tacked in at 4 wind from North steered on the wind all day on both tacks saw hump backs so ends Latt by obs 20-30 S Long by Chro West Trinidad 15 miles dist

Thursday 6th the Bogins with light breezes from off the North at sundown took in sails stow of watches the middle and latter part the same at sunrise one ship to the North land 45 miles dist so ends Latt by obs 20-31 S Long by Chro 20-06 West

Friday 7th the Bogins with light air from West land bore S E 42 miles dist at 4 PM at 5 1/2 AM took a light breeze from S E steered N by W with a fine breeze Latt by obs 19-44 S Long by Chro 30-40 West

Saturday 8th the Bogins with a fine breeze from S by E steered N by W saw a m bark on both tacks at sundown took in sails and steered the same the middle and latter part the same at 10 AM had been hump backs steered to the N by W boat landed him from the vessel took him along side at 1 1/2 PM commencing cutting out till dark and set the rest by all night Latt by obs 18-30 S Long by Chro 32-00 West

Steered on N by W back to the off the boat
