

Sept 49 Remarks on Board the Cutter and

Saturday 5th the Bogies with strong breezes and squally saw hump backs the middle and latter squally with showers of rain on both took wind from N.W. standing to the S.W. Lat by obs 14.26 South Long by Chro 35-50 West

Sunday 6th the Bogies with squalls of rain wind from the north stood to the Eastward the middle and latter part the same the wind shifted in the night to the South so Lat by obs 16.34 S Long by Chro 35-00 West

Monday 7th the Bogies with strong breezes and rugged from the south in the morning saw a sail steering to the N.W. took to the west the middle and latter part the same at daylight stood to the S.W. and N.W. saw two sails so Lat by obs 16.25 S Long by Chro 36.25 West

Tuesday 8th the Bogies with strong breezes from S.W. stood to the East at sunrise bore ship to the S.W. saw two sails so ends this 24 hours Lat by obs 16.00 S Long by Chro 35.50 West

Wednesday 9th the Bogies with strong breezes from S.W. at sundown bore ship to the East the middle and latter squally at daylight bore ship saw two sails one like lemon steering to the North Lat by obs 16.14 S Long by Chro 36.24 West

Thursday 10th the Bogies with light airs and strong breezes from S.W. the middle and latter light airs at sunrise saw a sail so ends this 24 hours Lat by obs 17.33 South Long by Chro 36.15 West

Friday 11th the Bogies with light airs and calm saw 5 sails at 12 took to the South wind all round the compass the middle and latter part light airs and calm stood to the South Lat by obs 18.06 S Long by Chro 36.19 West

Saturday 12th the Bogies with light airs and calm saw five backs took the bows at sundown bore ship the middle and latter part strong breezes from N.W. saw a whaling bark we run off before the wind so ends Lat by obs 17.42 S Long by Chro 36.45 West

Sunday 13th the Bogies with a strong breeze at 3 Pm spoke saw bark the bark Bremen New Bedford the Capt went on board the middle and latter part a strong breeze from N.W. at sundown bore ship to the N.W. at 12 took to the S saw a sail Lat by obs 17.33 S Long 37-25 West

Monday 14th the Bogies with a strong breeze from N.W. stood to the East at 4 pm saw a sail the middle and latter part calm and all round the compass Lat 17.50 South Long 36.45 West

Tuesday 15th the Bogies with a squall from South heading to the S.W. fished fore topsail and reefed mainsail close reefed main topsail at dark bore ship to the N.W. got the west boat stove the middle the same at sunrise bore ship and set fore topsail and fore sail so Lat by obs 17.27 S Long by Chro 36.00 West

Wednesday 16th the Bogies with more moderate at 5 Pm saw a bark the middle and latter a fine breeze from S.W. stood to the South west repaired fore spinnaker so ends this 24 hours Lat by obs 17.37 South Long by Chro 36.30 West

Thursday 17th the Bogies with fine weather saw a sail and broke out main hole for head the middle and latter part fine weather at 9 Pm saw sperm whales one bore and chased at 3 Pm aboard boat went along side and missed at 6 took up the boat Lat 18.06 S Long by Chro 36.40 West

Friday 18th the Bogies with fine weather chasing a large sperm whale the middle bore ship at 4 Pm bore ship to the East wind N.W. saw a m big so ends Lat 17.40 S Long by Chro 36.30 West
