Saturday 19th The Begins with fine weather At 12^{1/2} noon before the wind southerly At 4 luffed by the wind to the East the middle part wore ship to the NW with light airs and calm so ends this day Lett by obs 17538 Long by Chro 36-30 West

Sunday 20th The Begins with light airs and calm caught two dolphins after supper had a swim the middle and latter part fine weather At Daylight had 1 more Commers killed. At 12 luffed ship to the South saw 1 sail so ends Lett by obs 17238 Long 36-40 West

Monday 21st The Begins with a fine breeze and fine weather brised from 28th had fees for supper the middle part wore ship 3-1-8 saw two sails changed signals with a dark man at 10 AM saw sperm whales at 11 land and struck to the NW boat lost 4 lines but got the whale and raised three of them took him strong side At 5 PM Lett 17410 Long 36-40 West



Tuesday 22nd The Begins with fine weather whaling the middle and latter part fine weather cut off the head at 12 so ends this 24 hours Lett by obs 17004 Long by Chro 36-58 West

Wednesday 23rd The Begins with the same At 12 a rain squall so ran south left the case till morning commenced boiling at 9 PM the middle and latter part fine weather let the cargo at 12 and wore ship to the East Lett by obs 17115 Long by Chro 37-05 West

Thursday 24th The Begins with fine weather looking for a mother whale the middle and latter part a fine breeze saw three sails so ends Lett by obs 17840 Long by Chro 36-30 West

Friday 25th The Begins with fine weather set the 2nd top sail the middle and latter part the same finished boiling at 4 PM and stood down 12 miles no fore hals wore ship at 8 PM so ends Lett by obs 17550 Long by Chro 36-15 West

Saturday 26th The Begins with fine weather staying down stood down all was fit the middle and latter part the same on both tacks saw spots and breaches all day finished staying down at 2 PM so ends this day Lett by obs 18002 Long by Chromometer 36-15 West

Sunday 27th The Begins with a fine breeze and fine weather heading to the North wind to the East the middle and latter part the same tacked at 4 PM to the East so ends Lett 17558 Long by Chro 36-05 West

Monday 28th The Begins with fine weather saw 1 sail in the morning the middle and latter part the same At 4 steered NW saw a hump back so ends Lett by obs 1752 Long 36-37 West

Tuesday 29th The Begins with fine weather steered S on wind At 8 at sundown luffed by the wind to the the middle part wore ship the latter saw a whale back so ends this 24 hours Lett by obs 17500 Long by Chro 36-30 West

Wednesday 30th The Begins with fine weather heading to the S-S-E At 4 PM tacked ship and spoke. Bark sparten the middle and latter part the same At sunrise tacked ship to the S saw sparten forced for black fish got none so ends Lett by obs 17410 Long by Chro 36-52 West

Thursday 1st The Begins with a fine breeze heading to the S-S-E saw 2 m ships the middle and latter part the same At sunrise tacked ship saw one whale mon so ends Lett by obs 17142 Long by Chro 36-48 West

Friday 2nd The Begins with fine weather broke out after hold for water and made a storm sail out of old gill the middle and latter part the same saw sparten At 12 m brig steered to the S-S-E at finished the storm sail so ends this day Lett by obs 17221 Long by Chro 36-40 West
