Saturday 3rd the Begins with light air and clear very pleasant the middle and latter part the same saw 1 sail saw porpoises 30 ends Latt by obs 17:55 S Long 36:40 West

Sunday 4th the Begins with fine clear weather at sun down set storm sail the middle and latter part the same At 12 tasked ship to the 30 ends this day Latt 16:25 S Long 36:45 West

Monday 5th the Begins with fine weather carried whole topsails three the light the middle and latter part the same At sunrise tasked ship saw 3 vessels people employed at sundown Latt 16:08 S Long 36:30 West

Tuesday 6th the Begins with fine light weather saw one sail luffed to the M at sunrise wore ship to the S & steered from S to S.W. saw 2 sails luffed cutting blocks strakes 30 ends this day Latt by obs 18:22 S Long by Chron 36:40 West

Wednesday 7th the Begins with fine weather at 4 pm about main topsails At sundown have back under double reefed topsails at sunrise steered S & W saw 2m sails repaired old main topsail 20 ends with a strong breeze Latt 18:24 S Long 36:50 West

Thursday 8th the Begins with the same steered from S & W to S.W. by 8 At sundown reefed the middle and latter part the same have now reefed the fore main and new fore lift steered S.W. 30 ends this day Latt by obs 18:14 S Long by Chron 36:00 West

Friday 9th the Begins with the same At 4 pm most calm bent old main topsails fore wore the middle part took a light breeze from S. At 2 1/2 At strong breeze from S & W with thick weather 30 ends Latt by obs 18:34 S Long 37:20 West

Saturday 10th the Begins with thick and rainy At sundown took in mainsail and fore sail steered S.W. the middle and latter strong winds from N. At the steered at sunrise we saw rips up fore top sail 30 ends this day Latt by obs 18:14 S Long by Chron 36:00 West

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Sunday 11th the Begins with a strong breeze from N. At 4 pm West and rigged no lifts three the day At sundown saw a small steered whole weather At 5 AM calm the wind breezed up from South at daylight saw a big steering towards the South in the wind hauled to the S.W. steered by the wind the then steered West 30 ends with thick weather Latt by obs 24:21 S Long by Chron 43:55 West

Monday 12th the Begins with a fine breeze from S & W with smoky weather steered West all sails set on flying jill the middle and latter light breeze and calm steered from W. S. W. to W. S. W. some times running and some times home about wind from all quarters and thick rainy weather latter part a strong breeze from South At 10 No long

Tuesday 13th the Begins with the same steered from N. W. to S.W. At 2 PM saw St. Sebastians made sail and took in sail luffed to and run At 9 AM bottom 100 bottom St. Sebastians island 2 PM

Thursday 15th the Begins with strong winds and thick weather At 1 PM luffed to the S & had have back saw a mother small island killed a speckle light wind from East At sundown braced forward and set fore and main sail At 5 in the morning saw ship At 9 AM saw the Corage At 10 of rocks are a mile long we passed 6 miles from the S.W. part of the largest At 11 steered W. N. W. for molar light or small island with a light on it 30 ends this day with more land in sight
