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Sunday 8th The Begins with some light air in the morning bore up and took one mit. and at 10 AM took a light breeze from S. bore up the anchor, made all sail, and beat out the bay took in once so &

Monday 9th The Begins saw account wind from East stored S. S. with a fine breeze. At 4 PM long by Chro was 63.5 standing whole watches the middle and latter part the same stored wind from N. at sunrise saw A sail, went new burst gaskets so & m at 25.55 S Long 45.58 W

Tuesday 10th The Begins with light breezes wind. Men people employed at ship's duties. At dark wind from South and squalls doubled, reefed the topsails the latter more worn so ends. Lat by obs 26.41 S Long by Chro 44.45 W

Wednesday 11th The Begins with strong breezes from S. S. W stored to the S. the middle and latter the same broke out fore broad - and repaired topsail, so ends this day. Lat by obs 28.44 S Long by Chro 43.40 W

Thursday 12th The Begins with clear weather and a strong breeze from S. S. W employed repairing topsail the middle and latter part the same finished the topsail and bent it so ends this 24 hours. Lat by obs 28.51 S Long by Chro 41.45 W

Friday 13th The Begins the same wind. Saw stores to the S. S. W people employed drawing yarns the middle part tacked ship headed west with light air and calm. At 4 AM ship to the S. S. painted waist boat rigging for right whales. Lat by obs 29.01 S Long by Chro 41.25 W

Saturday 14th The Begins with light air and calm painted stern boat grinding spades the middle and latter part calm broke out after. Sold for Apples Molasses sent down. Bore sail to repair so ends this 24 hours with a calm. Lat by obs 29.12 S Long by Chro 41.30 W

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Sunday 15th The Begins with calm repaired foresail, turned up waist boat took a light breeze from South the middle and latter part a light breeze from S. S. stored. S. S. W saw plenty humpbacks so ends this day. Lat by obs 30.02 South Long by Chro 42.30 West

Monday 16th The Begins with a fine breeze from S. S. W stored S. S. W humpbacks in sight the middle and latter part the same made toggles straps spungarn flat on a plank in the waist and at night. All ready for right whales so ends at 12 o'clock. Lat by obs 31.47 South Long by Chro 43.40 West

Tuesday 17th The Begins with light breezes from East stored S. S. W saw a turtle the middle and latter part stored S. by m. At 8 AM spoke the ship. Nantucket 50 m out bound to the north. Rigs in Jelying jibboom sent down royal yards so & Lat by obs 34.22 S Long by Chro 44.20 West

Wednesday 18th The Begins with a strong breeze from North stored S. by m sent down. Bore top galiant. Saw a French Scorer changed signals with her got out sugar the middle and latter. Fresh gales from N. At 6 AM luffed by the wind to the N. W. under close reefed main topsail. And spinnaker with lots of rain so ends. Lat by obs 36.30 South Long by Chro 45.00 West

Thursday 19th The Begins with fresh gales and rain. At 3 PM light winds and raged. At 6 PM wind luffed to the N. the middle part fresh gales from S heading to the N. ward jibed fore topsails and fore sail under close reefed main top. The latter part the same so ends this 24 hours. Lat by obs 38.46 S Long by Chro 44.25 West

Friday 20th The Begins with fresh gales and clear. Caught a 2 porpoises. At 6 PM wore ship to the S. S. W. set the fore sail and double reefed main topsail the middle and latter part light breezes. At sunrise made sail broke out fore hole for water. At 10 AM to Cooper. The Broad saw A sail. A storm steering on the wind top the S. S. W so ends. Lat 38.41 S Long 45.40 West
