Sunday 6th the Begins with strong winds and foggy the wind from North the middle and latter part thick strong breezes from N to West at 10 AM saw right whales the back rises in sight at 11 AM saw a boat started doubled the iron up came on board Lat 37-06 S Long 26-16 West

Monday 7th the Begins with a strong breeze from W spoke the river got better stay at the after noon had for fine backs the middle and latter part light airs and calm but best Boresail saw lots and lots of fine backs so Eward this day

Tuesday 8th the Begins with light airs and calms saw back rises. Saw Boresail 8 AM 200 fms the middle and latter part light airs and calms plenty fine backs so Eward this day
Lat by obs 36-03 S Long by obs 24-30 W

Wednesday 9th the Begins with light airs from N steered to the South to find a whale the middle and latter part light airs from N-E steered to the South westward at 10 AM saw a whale back 3 boats but the big galley him Lat by obs 37-54 S Long 25-18 W

Thursday 10th the Begins with fine breezes from N-E steered to the westward saw scattering birds at long swell from the and blue water with discouraged for this cruise the middle and latter part a fine breeze from North steered to the west little breeze not to be
Lat by obs 37-28 S Long by obs 26-30 W

Friday 11th the Begins with a fine breeze from N At sundown were ship to the E at sundown stood to the West Boresail breezes and thick took in fore topsail. so Eward this at sundown
Lat by obs 37-16 S Long by obs 26-00 W

Saturday 12th the Begins with strong winds and thick some rain at sundown were ship close to the middle and latter part the same steered to the South set fore topsail so Eward
Lat by obs 37-04 S Long by obs 26-10 W

Sunday 13th the Begins with a fine breeze from N the steered South saw fine backs thick fog the middle and latter part light breezes and fog steered to the S-E saw fine backs so Eward this
Lat by obs 37-12 S Long by obs 25-50 W

Monday 14th the Begins with light breezes from West steered to the S-E the middle and latter Calm saw grampuses and a hump back finch
Lat by obs 37-16 S Long by obs 24-30 W

Tuesday 15th the Begins with light airs from North steered to the S-E saw fine backs the middle and latter part strong winds from N-W steered to the S-E saw Blackfish at 11 AM squally with rain took in fore topsail. so Eward Lat by obs 37-36 S Long by obs 25-24 W

Wednesday 16th the Begins with a gale of wind from N to S-E were ship to the N at 4 PM wind from N took in Boresail at 5 PM more moderate the middle and latter light airs and calm on both tacks saw Whales so Eward Lat by obs 37-49 S Long by obs 25-24 W

Thursday 17th the Begins with light airs from South saw Blackfish the middle and latter part light breezes from N steered South so Eward
Lat by obs 38-04 S Long by obs 25-17 W

Friday 18th the Begins with a strong breeze from N saw Whales at 4 PM saw a back at 5 PM saw right whales had got none the middle and latter strong winds with rain with Boresail took in fore topsail. saw fine backs on both tacks Lat by obs 38-20 S Long by obs 25-16 W
