Remarks on Board the states 1852

- Thursday the 27 Begins with strong breezes from S to SW tacked to the S Eastward the middle and latter the same saw a sail on both tacks Lat 18°20' S Long 38°10' E
- Friday the 28 Begins with strong breezes from S to SW the middle and latter the same Lat 18°20' S Long 38°09' East
- Saturday the 29 Begins with strong breezes and squally on both tacks saw a sail the middle and latter the same Lat 19°20' S Long 37°02' E
- Sunday the 30 Begins with squally and a lighter breeze heading from the S to SW the middle and latter strong on both tacks Lat 20°11' South Long 36°24'
- Monday the 31 Begins with strong breezes from S to SW saw blackfish the middle and latter the same on both tacks Lat 20°55' S Long 35°59' East
- Tuesday the 1 of June Begins with a fine breeze from South heading to the NW saw fish boat bore yard saw the land 2 points on the lee bow 50 miles off the middle and latter the same in the morning saw the land Lat 20°56' Long 37°06'
- Wednesday the 2 Begins with fine breezes from S tacked off shore in shallow water and 15 m off bearing SW by W saw a turtle the middle and latter the same Lat 21°00' S Long 36°58' East
- Thursday the 3 Begins with strong breezes and squally tacked ship to the S West the middle and latter the same at 12 saw breakers thick and squally so tacked ship to the E Lat 22°05' S Long 35°34'
- Friday the 4 Begins squally heading to the E the middle saw the land and tacked ship to the S latter part saw the land all day current setting to the S we sent down mainsail reefed Lat 22°37' S Long 35°50' East
- Sat the 5 Begins with strong breezes from S on both tacks sent up mainsail at sundown land in sight the middle and latter squally beating up shore land in sight 12 miles off at 12 tacked off Lat 23°29' S Long 35°38'

June 6

Czera pickens master H Bound in June 1852

- Sunday the 6 Begins with strong breezes from S to SSW on both tacks land in sight set up top gallant rigging fore and aft the middle and latter the same Lat 24°14' S Long 36°23' East
- Monday the 7 Begins with calms threw out there 24 hours so Encls Lat 24°46' S Long by Encls and Lamers 36°23'
- Tuesday the 8 Begins with light breezes from S to SSW heading to the SW the middle and latter the same so E made royal rigging Lat 25°15' S Long 36°16' East
- Wednesday the 9 Begins with calms making royal rigging the middle and latter light airs from S to SSW steered S West Lat 25°52' South Long by Encls 35°38' East
- Thursday the 10 Begins with light breezes from S to SSW steered S West with all sail set last night saw 5 schools of blackfish struck a porpoise the middle part a fine breeze from North the latter a fresh breeze from S West saw fin back Lat 26°00' S Long 35°50' East
- Friday the 11 Begins with light breezes from S West with a strong current with a steered to SW the middle part a gale of wind from SW fished birds topsails and fore sail the latter more moderate heading to the westward Lat 26°21' Long 35°33' East
- Saturday the 12 Begins with fine breezes from S tacked steered to SW most calm took in waist Boat all sail set the middle calm till 2 o'clock then took a breeze from S E the latter from S E to North so Encls Lat 27°20' S Long 32°55' East
- Sunday the 13 Begins with a fresh breeze from S steered to SW at sundown the wind from S E the middle part the same the latter calm Lat 31°20' Long 31°36'
- Monday the 14 Begins with calms wind by S is the course the middle wind from SW on both tacks the latter calm saw a sail steering E Lat 31°52' Long 30°22' E
- Tuesday the 15 Begins with a calm at 4 Am took a light air from East ward by 8 half S is the course the middle and latter light breezes from S to S Lat 32°30' S Long 29°20' East
- Wednesday the 16 Begins with light breezes from S steered to the westward Lat 4 Am land 12 miles off the middle saw light on shore the latter took a breeze from East to S Lat 33°30' S Long 28°26' E
