Remarks on Board the U States of Westport

Tuesday the 20 Begins with a fresh breeze from S E steered N by W and N by E saw a sail steering N N W the middle and latter part the same people employed rattling and taring down
Lat 6° 50' S Long 18° 45' West

Wednesday the 21 Begins with a fine breeze from S E steered N by E saw said sail steering after over the middle and latter the same people employed rattling down and taring and painting the mast heads Lat 5° 12' S Long 21° 00' West

Thursday the 22 Begins with a fine breeze from S E to E steered N by E half W the middle and latter the same so E Lat 3° 25' S Long 22° 15' West

Friday the 23 Begins with a fine breeze from S E by S steered N by E to S sundown then steered N N W people employed rattling taring and painting took a suner the middle and latter the same Lat 1° 38' S Long by Chron 24° 00' West

Saturday the 24 Begins with more moderate steered S N W people employed rattling and painting finished rattling down the middle and latter moderate saw sails and a shoal of Black fish 50 fms Lat even Long 25° 40' West

Sunday the 25 Begins with light breezes from S E steered N N W took some suners the middle and latter the same saw a sail steering N N E saw fine barks and a breech Lat 2° 02' North Long 26° 40' West

Monday the 26 Begins with a fine breeze from S E to S E steered N by W the middle and latter the same Lat 3° 54' N Long 27° 40' West

Tuesday the 27 Begins with a fine breeze from S steered N a head current the middle and latter squally wind from E to W Lat 15° 34' N Long 28° 30'

Wednesday the 28 Begins with light breezes from S E to West and rain steered N by W saw a M Bark in the fore noon steering to the N N E saw a shoal of B fish the middle and latter strong breezes and squally saw a sail steering to the E and on the wind Lat 7° 26' North Long 29° 40' West
