

Remarks on Board the U States of Westport 1852

August Friday ^{11th} Begins with a fine breeze from N.E. to N.W. steered a rap full the middle and latter by the wind saw Gulf weade so ends
Lat by obs 21.42 N Long 42.00 West

Saturday ^{12th} Begins with light breezes from N.E. to N.W. steered by the wind to the N.W. the middle and latter steered N by W so E got a lunar
Lat 23.01 North Long by Obs 42.50 West

Sunday ^{13th} Begins with light breezes from E to S.E. steered N by W the middle and latter the same in the morning saw a sail steering to the west
Lat 24.39 N Long 43.50 West

Monday ^{14th} Begins with fine breezes from S.E. by E steered S by W. At sundown carried away fore topmast head in the morning sent down royal and top gaint yard and top gaint mast and worked on the main topmast
Lat 26.49 N Long 44.30 West

Tuesday ^{15th} Begins with fine breezes from N.E. to E steered North got the topmast ready to go up in the morning the middle and latter moderate this fore noon sent up topmast so ends
Lat by obs 28.28 North Long 45.00 West

Wednesday ^{16th} Begins with light breezes from E to S.E. steered North got up all the masts and gars set fore top gal studdensails the middle and latter light airs cleaned ship and painted out side Lat 29.32 North Long

August

Thursday ^{12th} Begins with light airs from N.E. by E steered N by W finished painting st side green the middle and latter light airs and calms people employed painting saw a sail steering to the N.E. on the wind we steered North
Lat 30.10 North Long 46.50 West

Friday ^{13th} Begins with light airs from E to E steered North finished painting Lab side out side the middle and latter the same saw sail people employed painting breeze from South so ends this 24 hours Lat 30.56 N Long 47.15 West

Saturday ^{14th} Begins with light airs from S to S.W. steered N finished painting the middle and latter the same at sunrise saw a topsail schooner a whaler steering E Lat 32.00 N Long 47.50 West

Sunday ^{15th} Begins with a fine breeze and squally steered to the North wind from S.W. to N.W. the middle and latter light breezes from E to W in the morning saw a schooner steering East
Lat 33.12 North Long 48.00 West

Monday ^{16th} Begins with light breezes and squally wind from west steered on the wind to the west and saw Blackfish this day the middle and latter wind from N.E. to N steered N.W. and N.W. by S
Lat 35.36 North Long 49.11 West

Tuesday ^{17th} Begins with light airs from S to S.W. heading to the westward the middle and latter heading to the N.W. latter saw 3 sail m. bark wind west Lat 34.04 N Long 50.00 West
