

Remarks on Board the U States S B Bound 1852

August ^{the} 30 Monday Begins with a strong breeze from
SW steered. Saw by W. W. saw a sail steering the
same foggy weather the middle a gale At 12 hauled
Fore topsail the latter set fore topsail and jib
and a single reef main topsail blowing strong
Lat 39° 02 North Long 68° 25 West

Tuesday ^{the} 31 Begins with strong breezes from the
heading to the N. N. W. this afternoon washed
the ship in side again with soap and fresh
water the middle and latter foggy At 10:20 AM
to the SW At 3 PM in the morning tacked again
to the North latter part saw 3 sails one whaler.
Bound out showed a signal blue white and blue
At 10 AM tacked again to the N. S. W. set
all sails Lat 40° 00 N Long 68° 30 W

Wednesday ^{the} 1 Begins with strong breezes from
SEPT N. W. steered to the N. S. W. saw several sails
thick foggy weather the middle and latter a
light breeze from west steered in shore the
latter saw several sail Lat 40° 00 N Long 69° 20 W

Thursday ^{the} 2 Begins with light airs found bottom 45 fms
wind from W steered in to the N. W. the middle
and latter a light breeze from S. W. steered
N. W. by W and S. W. by N saw several
sails some from 60 to 28 smoky weather
Lat 40° 50 N Long 70° 20 W

Friday ^{the} 3 Begins with a light breeze
from W. S. W. steered N. W. with all
sails set and left St. Johns sails

Sunday Home on the 1st of August 1852 arrived after
a fair to bark to Fall river.
