 Ships. All these 24 hours fine weather &
 light air so ends.

Sunday 16th

 and light air from the Southward
 Ship under all sail standing to the South
 and East. at latter part lowered two Boats
 for Black fish but without success 3 or four
 Sails in sight Lat 37° 10' Long 69° 51' W 3

Monday 17th
~~Friday~~ Com. with light air and pleasant
 weather at 4 o'clock caught a porpoise made out Boys
 Cook, wild to think that we were a going to
 eat it. At middle part light air. Latter part
 smart breeze from the Southward and Westward
 bears S by E. Lat 35° 40' Long 4

Tuesday 18th All these 24 hours smart breeze
 from the S and fine weather bore S by E. Low tide at three
 Sails Latter part sent up the Royal yard

Wednesday 19th First part Light air
 and fine weather sent up the Main
 Main Royal yard. Middle part Light
 air. Latter part smart breeze from
 the Southward & Westward under
 short sail, heaving to the South & East
 Lat Long 6
