

Bark bathrona bound for home
Sunday August 11th 1850

All this 24 hours
light air from S.W. steering S.W. by W.
At first part 3 P.M. passed a Brig standing to S.W.
Later part passed a Schooner bound to Barbados
19 days from Halifax bound to Barbados
do ends fine weather & light wind.
Lat 26.25th Long 58.10th

Monday 12th

All this day light air from S.W. by W.
steering S.W. by W. At later part 10 P.M. Boat went on
board of the Schooner bound to Eastport
19 days from Philadelphia bound to Trinidad
do ends Lat 26.43th Long

Tuesday 13th

All this day fine weather & most of
the time calm. At later part spoke Schooner
bound 10 days from Baltimore bound to one of
the West Indies. Lat 27.12th Long 57.32th

Wednesday 14th

All this 24 hours hot calm disagreeable
weather with now & then a breeze.
Lat 27.15th Long 57.57th

Thursday 15th

This 24 hours the heat still - calm
middle part had a light breeze from the Southward
& Westward. saw one Sail of course W. N. W.
Lat 27.30th Long 60.40th

Friday 16th

The first part calm. Middle part
light air from Southward & Westward. Later part calms
& air light course W. N. W. Lat 27.54th Long 61.32th

Bark bathrona in the Solomons a trying to get home
Saturday August 14th 1850

This 24 hours had the wind
from all points of the compass with calms a part of the time
& at the end of this day of trouble our Lat 28.22th
& Long 61.25th

Sunday 15th

All this 24 hours heavy squalls
from the Northward & Westward between squalls heavy wind & calms
at first part 3 P.M. spoke the Schooner bound to Quebec
of St. Johns. 16 days from ——— bound to Quebec
do ends with Solomons & a brig in sight
Lat 28.45th Long 61.26th

Monday 19th

First part a little of all sorts middle
part a light air from the S.W.
Ship heading from W to W. N. W. Later part fine
breeze from S.W. steering S.W. by W.
Lat 28.54th Long 63.45th

Tuesday 20th

This day begins with light air from
N.E. steering S.W. by W. passed a Schooner standing to East
middle part air light steering S.W. Later part wind
hauled to South. do ends with light air steering S.W.
Lat 29.19. Long 64.45th

Wednesday 21st

Course set fine weather & a
light breeze from S.W. steering S.W. passed a Schooner
standing to South. Middle part wind hauling to West
(Heavy Thunder squalls & strong wind. Later part
wind hauled to S.W. hauled to Southward &
put her under close reef main & fore sail.
do ends with rain & wind set a head.
Lat 30.29th Long 65.32th
