Park Bathurwood bound to St Helena
Latitude 33.36 North Longitude 13.00 East

786 Saturday June 1st 1850
The first & middle part blowing a heavy gale from the Westward heading from S.E. to S.W. Latter part wind hauled to N.W. daylight kept off N.E. & S. Ends with heavy gale

787 Latitude 33.36 North Longitude 13.00 East

788 Sunday 2nd
This 24 hours begins with a gale at first part wind hauled a head again took in Hardsail & fore & a gain blew reefed main & top sail.

(Ch. Lear I meant to get home. Middle part the same Latter part moderating some clouds reefed top sails & Hardsail heading to South No Ends

Latitude 31.49 North Longitude 13.05 East

Monday 3rd
788 These 24 hours commences with pretty good weather for the season wind hauling to South & W. steering N.E. & W. Middle part same. Latter part Light air from S.E. & W. All hands employed repairing, all main sail spanker & jib finished main sail & bent him.

Latitude 30.18 North Longitude 11.48 East

789 Tuesday 4th
All this day Light air from Southward steering N.E. & W. saw a ship steering the same that's weather. No. Latitude Longitude

Wednesday 5th
All these 24 hours strong H.E. Grades steering N.E. & W. Latter part saw a sail off Starboard quarter the same with us

Latitude 28.36 North Longitude 8.12 East

790 Thursday 6th

(All this day strong Trades the sail out of sight steering N.E. & W. Latitude 25.33 North Longitude 5.28 East

Friday June 7th 1850

791 All this day strong Trades steering N.E. & W. which is N.E. Latitude 23.49 North Longitude 2.43 East

792 Saturday 8th
The first part of this day smart Trades middle & latter parts light steering N.E. & W. Smokey weather the obs.

793 Sunday 9th
All this day Calm Latitude 22.14 North Longitude 58 Miles East

794 Monday 10th
The first part of this day light air from the Southward & Westward heading to North & East Middle & latter parts light air from S.W. steering N.E. & W. Latter part saw a sail coming up with us. Latitude 21.14 North Longitude 31 Miles East

795 Tuesday 11th
All this day commences with light air from S.W. & fine weather. Middle part wind hauling to S.E. Ends with wind S.E. back off Starboard being Latitude 20.05 North Longitude 48 Miles East

796 Wednesday 12th
These 24 hours begins with fresh Trades & fine weather (West Longitude thank God) & ends the same. Latitude 18.30 North Longitude 2.44 West

Thursday 13th
First part steering N.E. & W. with standing sail & main Royal. All sundown hauled in standing sails & boats reefed & raised up on the larboard Deck heading S.W. (going to look for Whales a spl) Latter part 4 merchant ships passed us steering to N.E. & W. Latitude 18.05 North Longitude 3.02 West
