Wednesday April 18th 1850

742 All these 24 hours light air from S.E. steering
S.W. saw a Latherwood ship steering to S.E.

743 Thursday 18th All this day light air from
South & East to S.W. & S.W. by W. Lat 8° 18' Long 48° 22'E

744 Friday 19th All these 24 hours light air from
S.E. steering to S.W. Lather part rigging Lat 8° 18' Long 48° 22'E

745 Saturday 20th All these 24 hours light
air from S.E. steering S.W. & West. Lat 8° 18' Long 48° 22'E

746 Sunday 21st These 24 hours begins with
light air from the South & fine weather
At first part Made Hazard Island one of the
Looe moles (middle part on opposite side
off the island with a light breeze. Latter part
steering S.W. by W. smart breeze from S.E.
Top mast & Main Top gal. Steady sails set
Lat 10° 13' Long 47° 22'E

747 Monday 22nd These 24 hours begins with
fine weather & a smart breeze from the Eastward
steering first to Middle part S.W. by W.
Latter part of this day rain squalls & baffling
winds no S.E.

Tuesday April 23rd 1850

748 These 24 hours begins
with rain & baffling winds at first part 3 P.M.
Made the Comoro Islands bearing N.W. by W. Johanna
& Mohela & Middle part became off Johanna & later part
the same 20 miles distant. Lat 3° of the Comoro
in sight

749 Wednesday 24th All these 24 hours begins
strong current setting to S.W. by W. Johanna 15 miles
dist. to Southward

750 Thursday 25th Commences with light air
from the South & West heading first part
from S.E. to S.W. by E Middle & latter part heading
all ways Comoro Johanna Mohela All in sight
strong current setting to S.W. by W.

751 Friday 26th All this day light air
& strong current a gusty wind. The Land still
in sight Lat 12° 22' Long 48° 00'E

752 Saturday 27th All these 24 hours had a fine
breeze from we could not weather Comoro
kept off N.W. by W. & went to leeward of it then hauld off
N.W. by W. so ends heading N.W. by W. no land in sight
South current Lat 13° 38' Long 48° 00'E

753 Sunday 28th At first part Made the
African Coast & Tacked off shore at 3 P.M.
Tacked in shore again heading from S.W. by W.
to S.W. Middle & latter part Tack & Tack
Wind from the Southward. Lat 14° 00' Long 48° 00'E
