

Bark Catherwood off low point or head of island
719 Sunday March 24th 1850
These 24 hours light air

fine weather low island
720

Monday 25th All this day fine weather no wind,
later part sent a boat ashore (got nothing)

721 Tuesday 26th All this 24 hours weather
At latter part steering S E for Myke

722 Wednesday 27th First part squally
Made the land & at 6 o'clock came to anchor
in the outer harbour. Later part hove up
& anchored in the inner harbour.

The Bark Bruce of Fairhaven &
the Ship Phoenix of New London
lying out side. As land air started

723 Sunday April 7th 1850

Commenced with light
air from all quarters & fine weather
At latter part 6 in the morning hove
up anchor. Anchored heading to Northward
of Little by J. My pretty French Girl
I hate to leave them but however I look
forward to the day when I shall be
home.

Monday 8th All this 24 hours squalls of rain
& wind from all quarters. Saw a bird
the windward side to the westward of Myke
in sight

Bark Catherwood off low point or head of island
734 Tuesday April 9th

The most of this day wind from all quarters
at first part spoke Ship Phoenix
of New London. The land in sight

735 Wednesday 10th All this day light air from
the Northward steering S W spoke Phoenix
later Long

736 Thursday 11th All these 24 hours light air
& calm at first part spoke Ship M. Lee
4 1/2 Mo. 8 25 Sp. Ends with light air
in company with Phoenix
Lat 4. 28 S Long

737 Friday 12th These 24 hours light air
from the NW steering S W by E in company
with the Phoenix Lat 5. 36 S Long 52. 55 E

738 Saturday 13 All this day light air from
the Northward & Westward heading to Westward
At latter part spoke a Pin's from Alder
bound to Myke short of water supplied her
backs in company with the Phoenix

739 Sunday 14th All this 24 hours light
air & head wind first part saw the
Island of All-hong, one of the off-shore
Islands in company with Phoenix
Lat 6. 55 S Long 52. 12 E

740 Monday 15th

All this day fine weather light
air from all quarters Phoenix in sight
Lat 6. 54 S Long 52. 12 E

741 Tuesday 16th All this day head wind made but
little progress later part Phoenix out of
sight Lat 6. 51 S Long
