in chase starboard boat got on to one started
black blubber did not fasten (looked like for me)
ends in chase Lat 4. 20 S Long 53. 12 E

702 Thursday 7th

Begins with fine weather at first
part 3 PM Jarboard boat succeeded in getting
a whale. (Thinks God for that) Latter part employed
cutting

703 Friday 8th All first part finished cutting
& boat boiling ends boiling fine weather
Lat 4. 16 Long

705 Saturday 9th

All this 24 hours fine weather
at latter part 4 AM finished boiling
Lat 4. 22 S

706 Sunday 10th

This day begins with fine weather
& light air & ends calm. Lat 4. 12 S

Monday 11th Fine weather & calm latter
part employed stowing down oil Lat 4. 10 S Long

708 Tuesday 12th

First part of this day calm employed
stowing down finished. Latter part light air from
the Northward steering E by N. Bent New Main Id. got
Sail. Lat Long 54. 14 E

Wednesday 13th

and fair

All this 24 hours light air
Lat 3. 57 South Long on the Edge of the
Bank

709 Thursday Wednesday March 14th 1850

All this day light air & fine weather
23 M^{ts} out of no whales in sight
Lat 4. 05 S Long 53. 12 East

710 Friday 15th

All this 24 hours light air & calm
heading to N by W. Lat 3. 45 S Long

711 Saturday 16th All this day fine weather & light air
steering to N by E.

712 Sunday 17th All this day light air at first part
made bow or about Island

713 Monday 18th This day begins & ends with light
air & no whales bow Island in sight.

714 Tuesday 19th First & middle parts light air & fine
weather latter part squally. saw the Island?

715 Wednesday 20th All this day squally weather
saw the Island.

716 Thursday 21st All this day squally weather
saw the Island. Lat Long

717 Friday 22nd This day begins with fair weather
& strong breeze from the Northward saw
Cen^{er} Island ends fine
saw whale lowered without success. going quiet.

718 Saturday 23rd All this 24 hours fine weather
& light air at first part saw another shoal
of small whales lowered but without success
(hard Luck) bow Island in sight
ends with fine weather & no whales
