Latter part of this day Employed stowing down oil

658 Tuesday 21st All these 24 hours strong
winds & rugg sea Latter part Employed
stowing down Oil Let

659 Wednesday 22nd All this day strong winds
from the Northward all first part finished
stowing down Latter part saw Cow Island

650 Thursday 23rd All this day fine weather
Looking for Whales

651 Friday 24th All this day weather fine
saw a Bark, but no Whales

652 Saturday 25th All this day like the other days
saw the Bark & Cow Island

653 Sunday the 26th The same

654 Monday 27th Do Do

655 Tuesday Feb 5th 1850

All these 24 hours strong winds. Spoke
Bark Heiter of Stonington 12 Mo
out 100 bbls.

656 Wednesday 29th All this day rugg
Spoke Bark George Porter Eld of Newbury
22 Mo 150 bbls

657 Thursday 30th All this 24 hours strong
winds from N.W. & as they usually are, saw the
Barks.

658 Friday February 1st 1851
(Last one day on the last Mo)
All this day fine weather
and strong winds from the Northward saw the
Barks & Cow Island

659 Saturday 2nd All this day fine
weather saw one Bark

660 Sunday 3rd This day weather fine
bought some Fish on the Bank off Cow Island
saw the George Porter

661 Monday 4th All these 24 hours
Employed repairing sails.

662 Tuesday 5th All this day fine weather
and fine breeze from the N.W. steering
West. (Bound off) first part Employed
mending sails - Latter part setting up Riggings
20 bbls stowing West
