Friday January 4th 1850

630 The first and middle part fine weather
Later part rain. at later part saw
spots supposed them to be sperm whales
5 miles to windward came on to low land
one of them on the edge of the bank;

631 Saturday 5th First and middle
part nasty - dirty rainy disagreeable
weather and as far as my self I am as
ugly as the ^{Evil} Evil but
went the last mainsail

632 Sunday 6th All this day calm
weather. strong current setting to Eastward
Maybe is right now rain

633 Monday 7th All this day slight air and
leaves. Later part employed repairing drift
Log sail & Spouters, so ends maybe is right

634 Tuesday 8th All first part light
air from the southwest, first part fine
morning Spouter & Jett Lashed. Later part some
rain. Lett 4th 45

635 Wednesday 9th All these 24 hours thick weather
wind from the North & Westward.
Lett 4th 30

636 Thursday 10th All this day like the rest

637 Friday 11th All this 24 fine weather
saw a number of Finbacks Lett 3th 50
Saw maybe,

Saturday January 12th 1850

638 All this day fine weather and smart breeze
from S.W. & trying to get to bow Island

639 Sunday 13th All first part fine weather
made bow Island, saw one ship & one boat

640 Monday 14th 21 Months out 700 sperm oil (hard but pure)
All first part spoke ship 7th Lee 800 2 1/2 Mts. saw a boat.
Later part spoke the 7th Lee again. so ends bow Is. in sight

641 Tuesday 15th All this day fine weather
saw the ship & boat. Saw Island in sight. Later part

642 Wednesday 15th All this day fine weather
saw Boat & ship. Saw Is & bow Island

643 Thursday 16th first part saw the Island
Later part saw 2 whales low in
Lark boat Capt Jasper from
Peter's part. Lost the 7th whale
65th whale. Ends taking 7th whale
with boat. Fillet of storing through May out 50 lbs

644 Friday 17th Commenced with fine weather
All first part 3 P.M. Lark boars boat struck
got the whale along side of 4th bow Island,
in sight ends cutting. Saw Is in sight

645 Saturday 18th

All this day fine weather
All later part saw a whale. Lark & boat
but without nose
