

Bark *Catherwood* off *Foyehelle Islands*  
520 Monday December 26<sup>th</sup> 1849

All this day fine weather and light air saw a ship  
to windward sailing

521 Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> All this day fine weather saw 2 or 3 ships  
later part steered down and *San Luis Island* in sight

522 Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> All this day fine weather  
all first part 5 P.M. spoke the ship *William Lee*  
of New Port, 20 Mts 350 Sp. Later part 2 sail  
in sight (8 the land) Let

523 Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> All this day weather fine all first part  
spoke *William Lee* Later part 2 sail in sight  
and *San Luis Island*

524 Friday 30<sup>th</sup> first part of this 24 hours fine  
weather Later part squally. Employed mending  
Starboard Boat *San Luis Island* in sight

525 Saturday December 1<sup>st</sup> 1849  
All this day fine weather  
526 *San Luis Island* in sight a part of the  
day

527 Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> All this day fine  
but no Whales the *Isle* in sight

528 Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> All this day fine weather  
Let 3.11 P.M. Long

529 Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> This 24 hours light air with  
rain squalls Let Long

Bark *Catherwood* off *Foyehelle Islands*  
600 Wednesday December 5<sup>th</sup> 1849

This day begins with light air and  
rain squalls Ends much the same

601 Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> The most of this day  
Let Long

602 Friday 7<sup>th</sup> 6 am with calm  
weather 8 am by latter part fine breeze  
from North steering from N.W. by W. to W.  
At 6 P.M. made the land  
*Myhee &c* so ends steering for the land  
Let Long

603 Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> All this day fine weather  
Land in sight

604 Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> All this day fine weather spoke  
Bark *George Washington*

605 Monday 10<sup>th</sup> These 24 hours light air and  
rain squalls spoke Bark *Hope* 25 Mts 1000 Sp  
bound Home, the *Islands* in sight 25 miles  
distant

606 Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> All these 24 hours squally weather  
the 2 Barks in sight so ends steering S.W.

607 Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> All this day as usual  
no Whales

608 Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> All this day fine steering  
to South by East Later part saw *Isle of Plat.*
