~~Wednesday~~ August 30th 1849

503 Thursday 30th Fine weather & light breeze
 at first part 5 P.M. came to anchor in
 the Harbor of Johanna. The next day the
 Bark Isabella of New Bedford came to anchor
 Lying off & on 29th M
 at 450 hrs. we lay off Johanna
 until the morning of the 8th September
 in which time we got wood - water - Best Food
 & fruit. & goats. & all hands a pretty good job.

512 Saturday September 8th 1849
 Bore North

All latter part
 got under way with a fine breeze steering
 to Northward.

513 Sunday 9th - Commenced with
 light breeze & fine weather all this 24
 steering N.E. Lat 10 44.

514 Monday 10th All this 24 hours fine
 weather & fine breeze steering N.E.
 Latter part all hands employed sorting
 over Potatoes &c Lat 7 40

515 Tuesday 11th All this day near
 B. breeze & fine weather for the
 Ocean. Lat 5 32 Long

516 Wednesday 12th All this day
 bark found. Latter part repaired
 Steerage N.E. Mule part by the
 wind heading to Westward. Latter part
 steering to North. Saw the Tale of
 Pemby

Bark Catherine of Pemby
 Thursday September 13th 1849

517 The first part of this day steering from North
 to N.E. saw the Land (Coast of Africa)
 Mule part by the wind heading to Eastward
 Lat 3 30 Long 42 00 E

518 Friday 14th All these 24 hours
 fine weather. Looking for Whales
 Lat 2 46 Long 41 30

519 Saturday 15th Commenced with fine
 weather & no Whales. End Emb the soul
 Lat 2 13 S

520 Sunday 16th All this day fine
 weather. Cont find our Whales in the
 Pasture Lat 2 15

521 Monday 17th All this day fine
 weather. Latter part employed repairing
 Fore Top sail. Lat 2 35 Long 40 30

522 Tuesday 18th All this 24 fine
 weather. No Whales. finished Fore
 Top sail & repaired Fore sail.
 Lat of no Whales & Long of

523 Wednesday 19th This day fine weather
 steering to Northward saw Pelagic fish
 Lat 1 30 Long 43 30
