Whales Lowered in chase but with out
success they was going like the Wind

fair. Lat 4.26.11 Long 43.21

482 Wednesday 8th All this
24 hours (breezy) winds bound to S. & E

483 Thursday 9th All There 24 hours strong
winds All latter part spoke Brig Columbus
of New London An - 13 Dec^r 250 St 7000
Ends Gamma with the Brig
steering to Eastward Lat 5.37 Long 43.20

484 Friday 10th All this 24 hours light
winds for these diggings at first part 7 P.M.
parted with the Brig
steering to Eastward Lat 5.17 Long 43.20

485 Saturday 11th All There 24 hours strong
winds ship heading to East of E by N.
Lat 4.48 Long 43.31

487 Monday 13th All This day strong
winds heading to S. & E. latter part
employed breaking out Shooks to set up
for Water when we got into the

488 Tuesday 14th This 24 hours Great
weather for this Ocean Bark heading to S. & E.
setting up Shooks. Lat 7.26 S. Long 43.40 East

Wednesday 15th All There 24 hours
fine weather of light breeze heading to S. & E.
setting up Shooks. Lat 9.02 Long 43.34

489 Thursday 16th All this day fine weather
Mid^dle part heading to Eastward latter part
heading to S. & West. Lat 9.51 S. Long 43.37

490 Friday 17th All There 24 hours fine
weather All this 24 hours heading from
S. & E. to S. E. at latter part 7 A.M. saw
a merchant Bark steering to S. & E.
Lat 11.26 S Long 43.52

491 Saturday 18th All There 24 hours
fine weather latter part of this day
heading to S. & E.
