473 Monday 30<sup>th</sup> com with strong winds  
at first part gave up the chase & came  
on board. Middle part strong wind  
Latter part 11<sup>th</sup> saw Whales Lowered  
Ends boats in chase

Lat 4.52 Long 42.00

474 Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> All first part  
Must Boat fastened. More Whales came  
up & Starboard Boat fastened (saw 10 & 11<sup>th</sup>) Starboard  
Boat fastened & parted. succeeded in taking 2 to the ship  
finished but my (A) & P.M. Middle & latter parts employed  
Boiling.

Wednesday August 1<sup>st</sup> 1849

This day begins as all the rest do strong winds  
and rugged at first part repaired Starboard Boat  
and employed Boiling. Middle part squally  
with a plenty of rain. Ends with strong winds  
& thick weather. Boiling Lat 1.50 Long

476 Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> com with strong  
winds and rugged finished boiling at  
4 P.M. Middle part rugged rainy nasty  
weather. Latter part thick and rugged  
No Lat Long

477 Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> com with squally  
heavy dark weather. Middle part squally. Latter  
part rugged employed slowing down at  
Lat 1.40 Long

478 Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> All Ghac 24 hours  
strong wind and heavy swell, first part  
finished slowing down at 4 P.M. at 3 P.M.  
saw Whales going quick to windward  
Lowered but without success. Latter part  
rugged weather Lat 1.46 Long 42.20



479 Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> All This day strong  
winds. Latter part heading to Eastward  
Lat Long
