Saturday July 14th 1849

457

The first part of this 24 hours finished
bailing. Latter part E. wind played stowing
down bil. Lat Long

458

Sunday 15th First part finished
stowing down bil. Latter part strong
winds

459 Monday 16th

All these 24 hours
strong winds trying to get up to windward
to get some Whales but the current says no.
Lat 2. 05 N. Long 44. 00 East

460 Tuesday 17th

All this day gained
about little towards our ground strong winds & wet
decks Lat Long

461

Wednesday 18th All these three 12
rigged weather carrying all sail but don't
gain to windward but slow
Lat 2. 13. Long 43. 00 E

462 Thursday 19th

All this day strong winds
& heavy swell as usual trying to get to
the South Lat 2. 30 Long

463 Friday 20th

This day begins
with strong winds & ends the same
like all the rest Lat 2. 34 Long

Bark Catherine, trying to get where

464 Saturday July 21st 1849

Shore last 24 hours
about the same as the rest
Lat 2. 44 Long 42. 30 E

465 Sunday 22nd

All this day as usual
Lat 3. 13 Long 42. 30

466 Monday 23rd

This day commences
am ends with Indian Ocean weather
Lat 3. Long 43. 15 East

467 Tuesday 24th

First & middle parts
strong wind gales or monsoons which ever you
may call them Latter part what they call fair
weather Lat 3. 15. Long 42. 16

468 Wednesday 25th

All these 24 hours
breezes are rigged no for this hours
Lat Long

469 Thursday 26th

All this pretty
fair weather for this place
Lat 3. 16 Long 42. 42
