Friday July 6th 1849

445 There 24 hours strong winds & rough
Latt Long

447 Saturday 7th Commenced with smart
breezes & rough sea all first part 3 P.M.
saw Whales lowered but without success
going too quick for compass

450 Middle part strong winds & fair weather
Later part 10 A.M. saw a Whale going
to windward lowered but could not come in
Latt 34 54 N Long 44 26 E

451 Sunday 8th All There 24 hours strong
winds & no Whales Latt 34 48 N

452 Monday 9th All There 24 hours strong winds
Later fair Latt Long 44 00 E

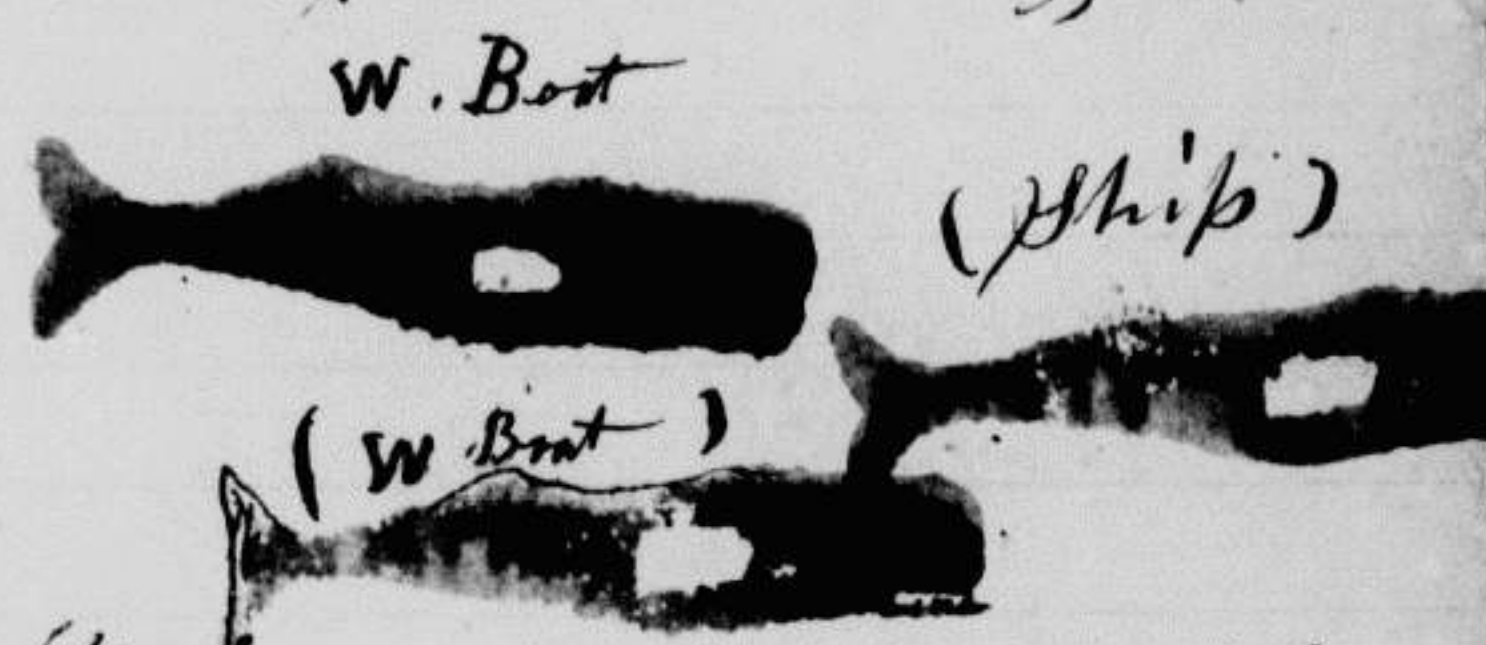
453 Tuesday 10th All There 24 fair weather
and strong winds all first part saw Whales
going to windward like lightning lowered but
without success. Middle part strong winds
Later part the same all 10 A.M. saw 3 Whales
lowered all 3 boats started just & chasing
Whales.

Wednesday



Bark Catherine doing the thing that is into
Wednesday July 11th 1849

454 Commenced with strong winds & fair
all first part from 2 to 4 took 5 Whales
to the ship & to the Starboard Boat & to
the Larboard Boat, & one to the West Boat
& one to the ship, got them along side
& got ready for cutting. Middle part strong
winds Laying by the Whales, Later part employed
cutting so ends Latt 24 46 Long 42 10



455 Thursday 12th Fair weather, all first
part employed cutting finished cutting
all 2 P.M. all 3 P.M. saw Whales
did not lower, Middle part boiling
Later part boiling

456 Friday 13th There 24 hours calm
with strong breezes employed boiling
all 3 P.M. saw Whales lowered
& Boats Larboard Boat fastened
from ~~down~~ ^(brake). Whales went to
windward, Middle part strong winds
& rough, Later part employed boiling
Latt 24 16 S Long
