all 12th at 10 o'clock Lat 19 06 Long 56 30

gales from N E commenced cutting
all 6 PM finished cutting & down
boiling Middle & latter parts Employed
boiling & weather growing better
Lat Long

404 Wednesday 23rd All these 24 hours fine weather
Employed Boiling latter part finished
boiling & washed off
Lat 17 41 Long

411 Wednesday 30th The first part of this
day All hands Employed repairing
sails equally middle & latter parts
Employed mending sails
Lat 16 57 Long

412 Bound Port

Thursday 31st commenced with fine
weather & smart breeze from
N E. Storing N E Employed mending
sails & sent out new 19 1/2 ft beam
middle part equally latter part
smart gales from N E & equally
storing N E & lat 14 1/2 Long
