Main sail. Lat 34.03.00 Long 46.14 E

Thursday 11th

All these 24 hours Light wind

Thus Ends these 24 hours with a Big Apple
Pudding Lat Long

Friday 12th

The first part Light air & no air
Latter part smart breeze from S.W. steering N.E. & E. Bear. Honey
Lat Long 47.14

273 Saturday 13th

All these 24 hours blowing from the
S.W. & E. steering N.E. Lat 48.00 Long 48.00 E

274

Sunday 14th

The first part strong breeze from East.
Middle part squally passed a Ship to Westward steering
N.W. Latter part fresh Gale from ESE. Short sail
Thus Ends these 24 hours. course N.E. & E. Lat 48.30 Long 47.54

275 Monday 15th

All this 24 hours blowing a Gale
of wind from the Southward & Eastward. Squally, rainy.
Homosick weather. Ch. that I was there this time to get
a good Supper & spent the evening with my dear parents
& my pretty Lucy
