This day commenced with
smart breeze from N.E. bore Ebb & G.
bound to the Indian Ocean & Cape. (Hutch part)
Aftering N.E. & E. Latter part saw a Whale
covered all three Boats in chase, but he proved to
be a hump Back. Late

Waggoners Jy
These 24 hours bombarded with smart
breezes from the Northward and Eastward bore
the first part 198 $66 \frac{1}{2}$ E. (My time on board
of the English Westporter (growing shorter every
day) mid & later much after the old East
Latt Long

What Tuesday 15th These 24 hours commenced with fine breeze from the Est & steering to S^W 8 miles to part staffing sails from all gear-ters Lull and rainy. Latter part made the Is^{le} of Trinidad. Employed making cutting penants.

Thursday Oct^r 16th 1848

213 By his day commenced with fine weather, steering
for the Land with a fine breeze from the
North, when, some showers of rain at 3 P.M. kept
off G.E. Misch & latter part bore G.E. & G. sent up
new cutting pendant. Lat 21° 31' N Long

Second of Kristen Storm,

814 Friday 17th. Common with fine weather
and light breezes from the Southward and
Westward. Sterling S.C., much light air from
all quarters. Latter part light airs and calms.
S.W. S.E. S. W. N. E. S. W. N. E.

315) Saturday 18th This day commences with
light air from all quarters, head viz
to the S. E. in a Breeze. Wind & T. Gate: Part
raining. Gate Long

516 Sunday 19th This day commences with the wind from S.E. & E. and Raining cold has to make a fellow think of home weather. Ship on opposite Tails. Night & part rainy, blazy weather. Latter part fine weather with heavy swell from the South wind E.S.E.
