179 Thursday 12th All there 24 hours
head wind make but little progress on our

180 Friday 13th All there 24 hours
breezes from the Southward ship heading West.
Oh dear Lucy Oh dear Mary Oh dear Susan
Oh dear do if I could so join the little boat
Mide & part smart breezes latter part the same
ship heading W. Lat 24 miles South = 41 W

181 Saturday 14th All there 24 hours smart breezes
from S. E. ship heading from W. N. W. to S. W.
at 7 in the evening captured 2 birds in
and shaved 8 of our boys. latter part saw
a Bark off our lee
Lat 24 miles South Lat 24

182 Sunday 15th All there 24 hours smart
with fresh breezes from the Southward
& Eastward heading W. N. W. latter part
smart breezes from S. E. heading from W. N. W. to S. W.
Lat 24 miles South Long 23 00

All there 24 hours smart S. E.
breezes heading from S. W. to S. E.
latter part employed setting up main rigging
Lat 24 miles South Long 23 00

184 Tuesday 17th All there 24 hours
smart breezes from S. E. weather
clear on sail steering to the
South & W. Lat 24 miles South Long 23 00

185 Wednesday 18th All there 24 hours
with smart breezes from S. E. steering
S. W. at first part exchanged rigging
with an English Bark steering S. W. by S.
at 5 P. M. Chalked the Long with
a Quaker Bird steering S. W.
at latter part Bark sent New
Main Ship sail course S. E. W.
Lat 24 miles South Long 23 00

186 Thursday 19th All there 24 hours
24 hours fine weather and fine
breezes from S. E. by S. course
S. W. employed repairing
at 10 M. ship sent
